### Project/News updates:

Charlotte provided update on youth work in Swavesey. The numbers have been as high as 23 at the Junior Club on Wednesday evenings. Charlotte is currently attempting to start up a girls group at SVC during a lunch time.

6 volunteers have come forward for youth group work. **Charlotte to liaise with Julie Bristow and take recruitment process forward asap.**

Charlotte also working with Gillian on Festival Committee.

The Bus project receives approx 16 young people at each fortnightly visit. There were reports of nuisance in the late evening following the last visit. However, it is not known whether any report was directly linked to a young person accessing the bus. **Jon to ask John Mason to be in the vicinity at the next bus visit.**

The total cost of the Festival of Youth event in November was £643. The logo competition went well and Charlotte presented the prize at SVC.

Charlotte asked if there was accessible funding to purchase a TV and craft materials for the Youth Group. Suzannah Harris allocated £500 to finance needs for youth group. **Jon to invoice.** Money available in SAY account for craft materials. **Jon to find out about wireless connections at youth centre.**

Group agreed to pay for table at Swavesey Festival on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> June. We will need volunteers to man the table and would like to involve junior youth club members. **Linda to send booking form.**

Linda confirmed that SAY will receive CCC grant for £2600 in April.

It was agreed to focus efforts on securing an informal meeting place for young people. Questions regarding this will be incorporated into the Parish Plan.

### Other Business:

Sue Marriott was removed and Debbie Gingell was approved as new bank signatory.

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There was some discussion about Webspaces on the Swavesey site. **It was agreed to leave this matter for decision at next meeting.**

It was agreed that we should start to use the new logo for all SAY correspondence. **Jon/Charlotte to source template document.**
