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Introduction

A total of 1030 Questionnaires were distributed during May and June 2008 and 450 containing data were returned, this gives a return rate of 44%. Each Questionnaire was designed to accommodate the answers from one to six individual respondents. The 450 returned Questionnaires contained the answers from 931 respondents

The Questionnaire contained 60 subject based questions separated into 11 sections. Eleven of the questions requested free text and these are omitted from this analysis as they are contained in a separate report. The 49 questions in this report consist of 285 individual question rows.

During data loading of the Questionnaires some errors in filling in the forms were found and trapped by the data loading software. The most common being multiple ticks in a 'Tick one only' question and ticks in the: 'Please insert:- P=Participate, I=Interested in, O= would help to Organise' question. Some assumptions were made to correct such errors. However the number of errors detected were reasonably small and would not influence the final result to any major degree.

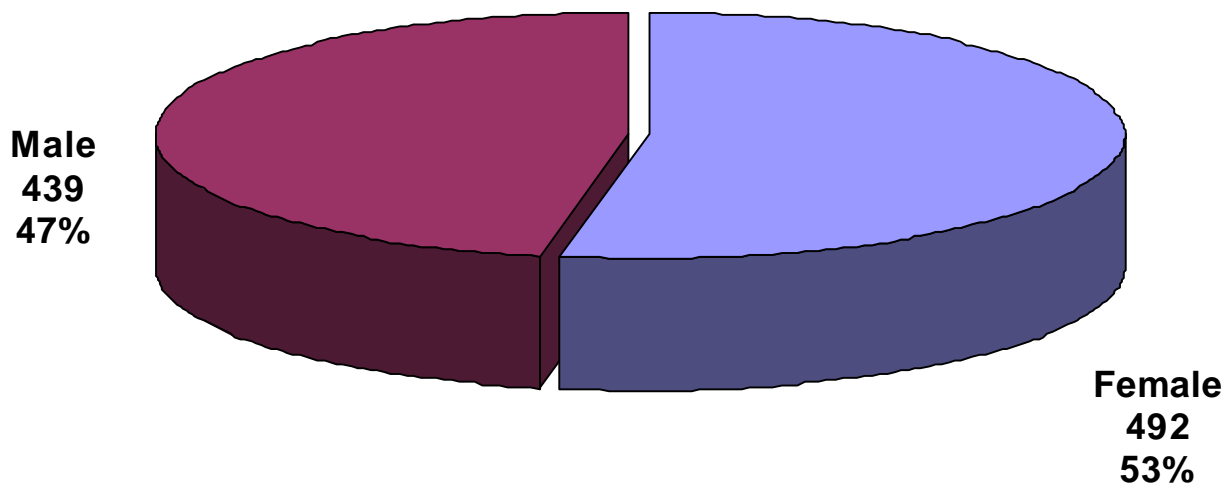
Virtually all returned Questionnaires had some unanswered questions and it was commonly found that children were entered on the first page giving sex and age but virtually no other questions were answered. A separate survey of school children was conducted at the Swavesey Village College and the results of this survey are contained in a separate report.

This report shows the data for each of the 49 non free text question subjects and although Q1 and Q2 record the Sex and Age of each respondent, the following questions are not broken down by Sex and Age. Should any village organisation be interested in the Sex and/or Age of the respondents for specific questions, then on request, it is possible to produce a more detailed analysis.

The analysis of each question also has a single row table at the bottom of each page giving the total individual respondents answering at least one or more question rows. The percentage compared with the total 931 respondents is also stated. (There are three questions where only one answer was required per questionnaire and these are compared to the 450 total questionnaires).

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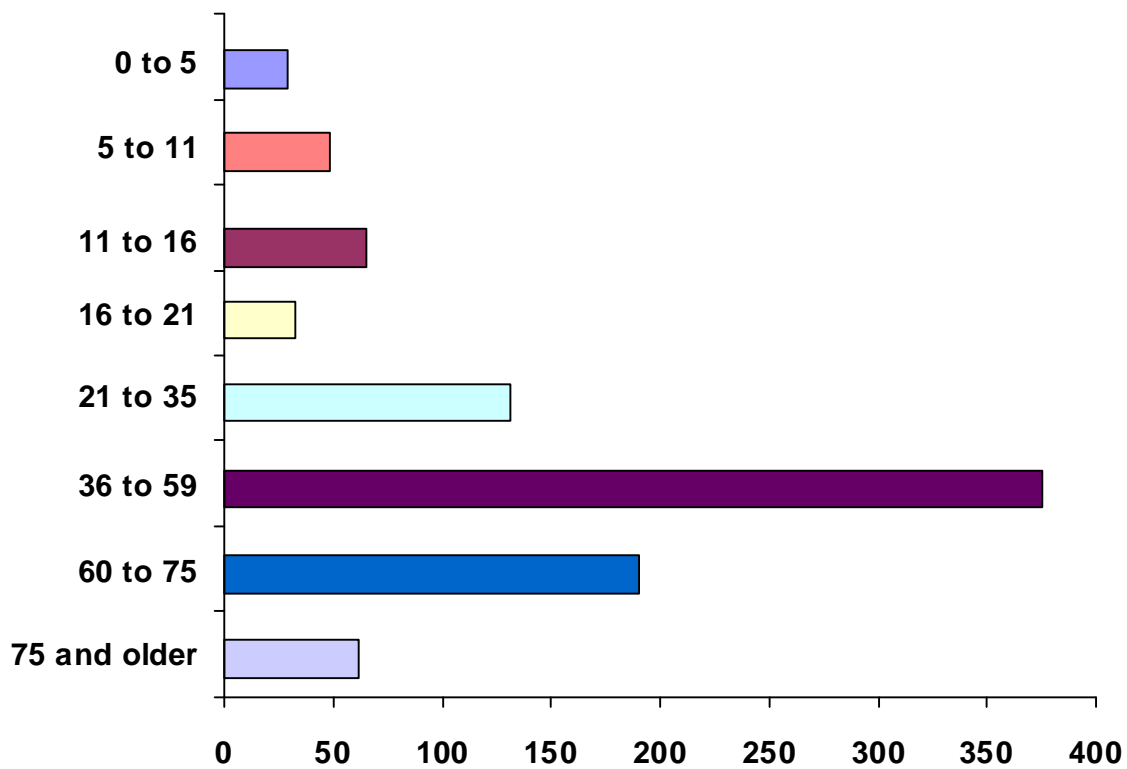
Q1: What sex is each person completing the form?

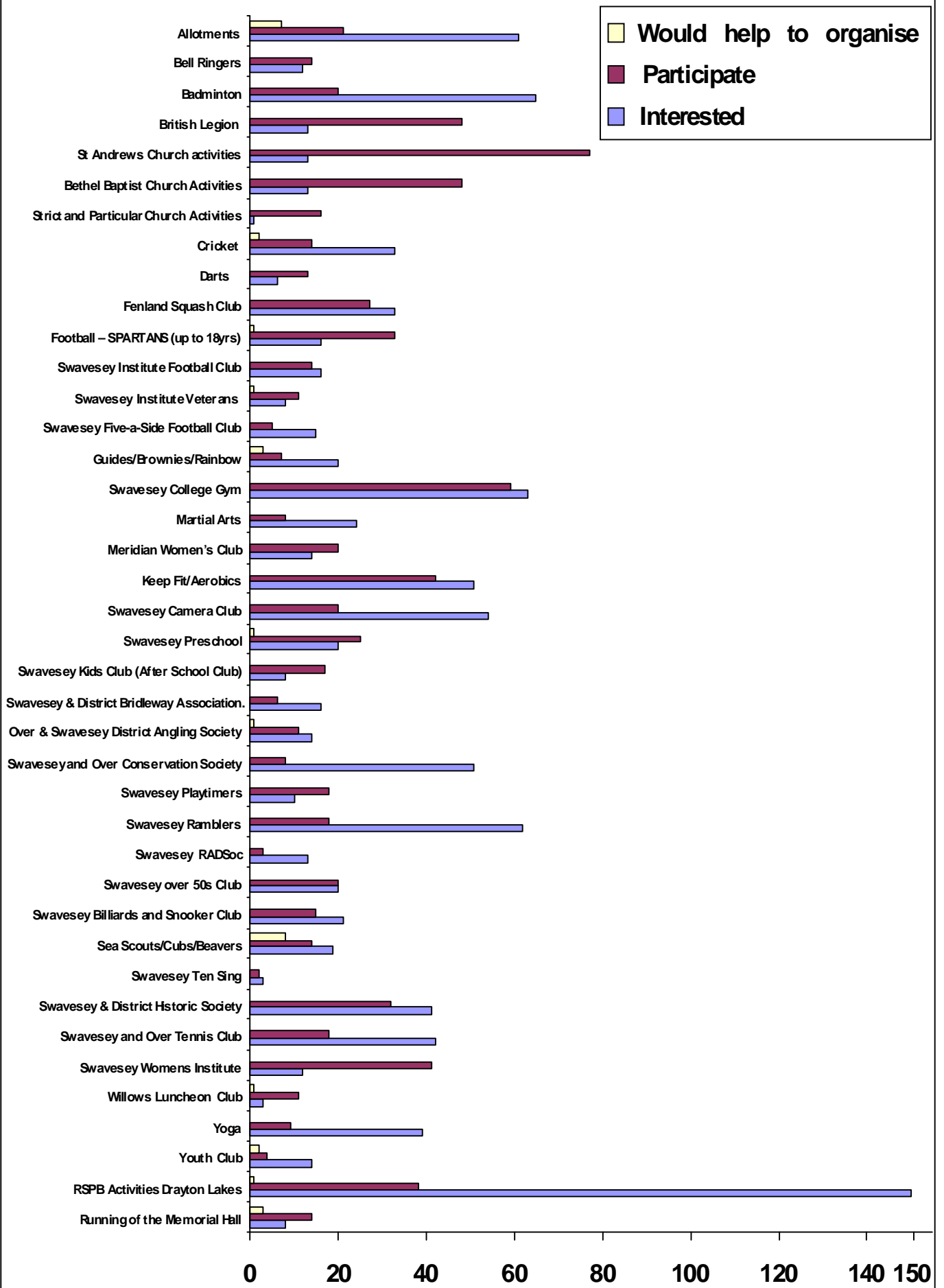

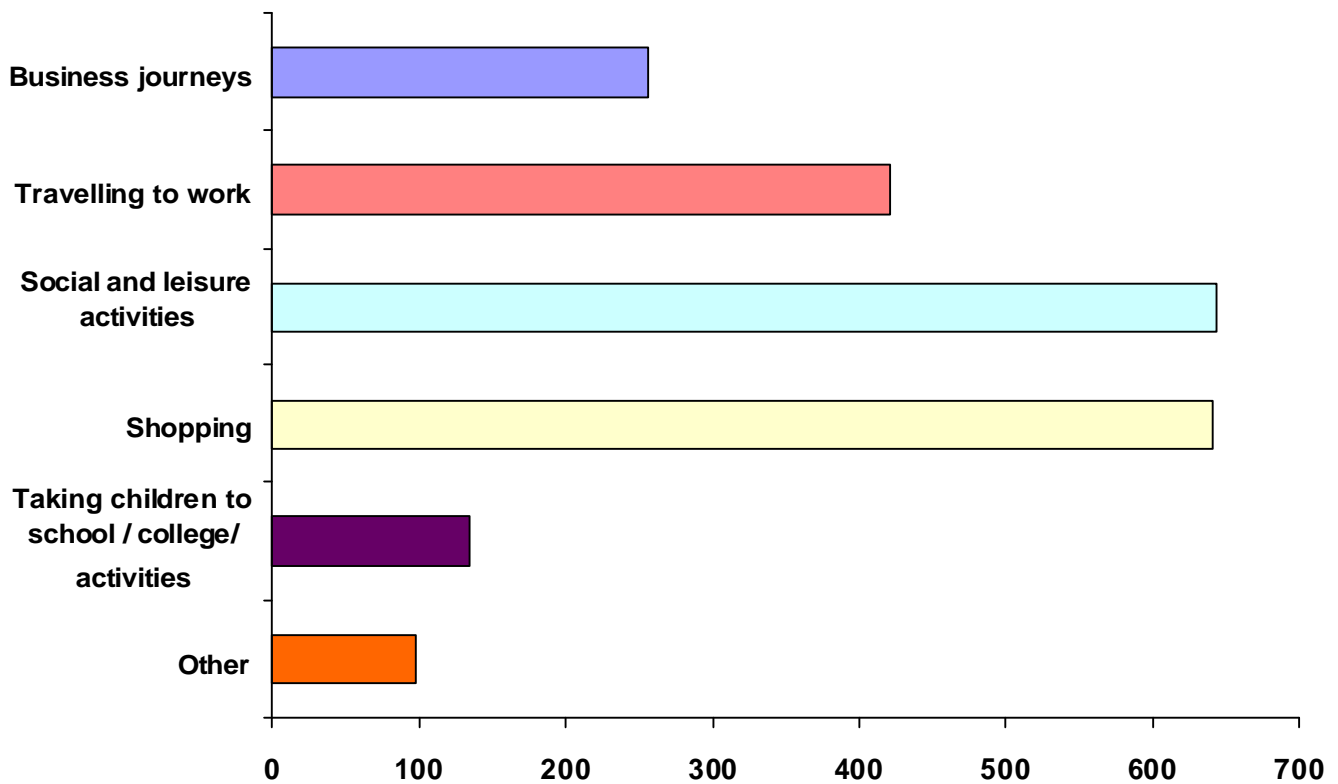
Q6 The District Council and others consulted have identified that Swavesey needs extra public space, for example community woodland, sports facilities, wildlife area. Do you...?

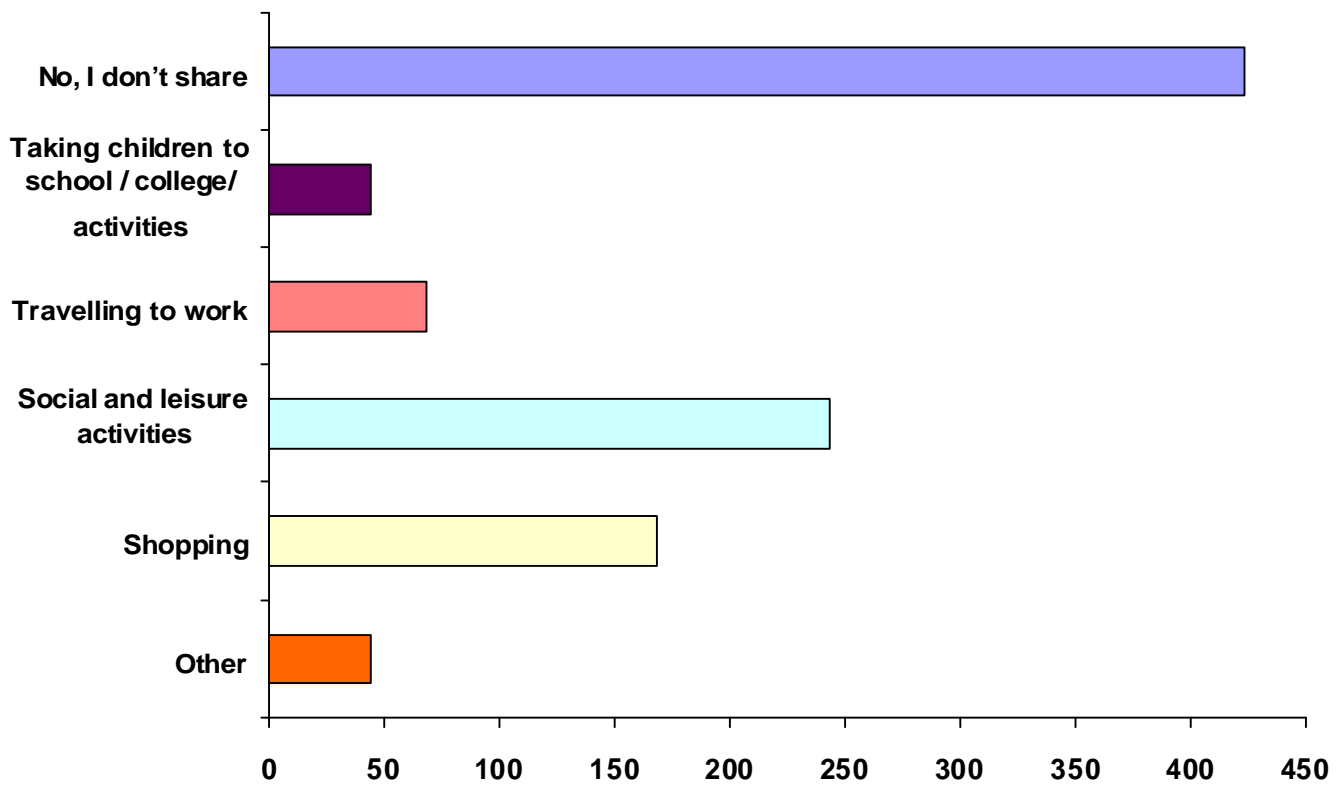
**Q8: If you use a motor vehicle, which of the following activities do you use it for?

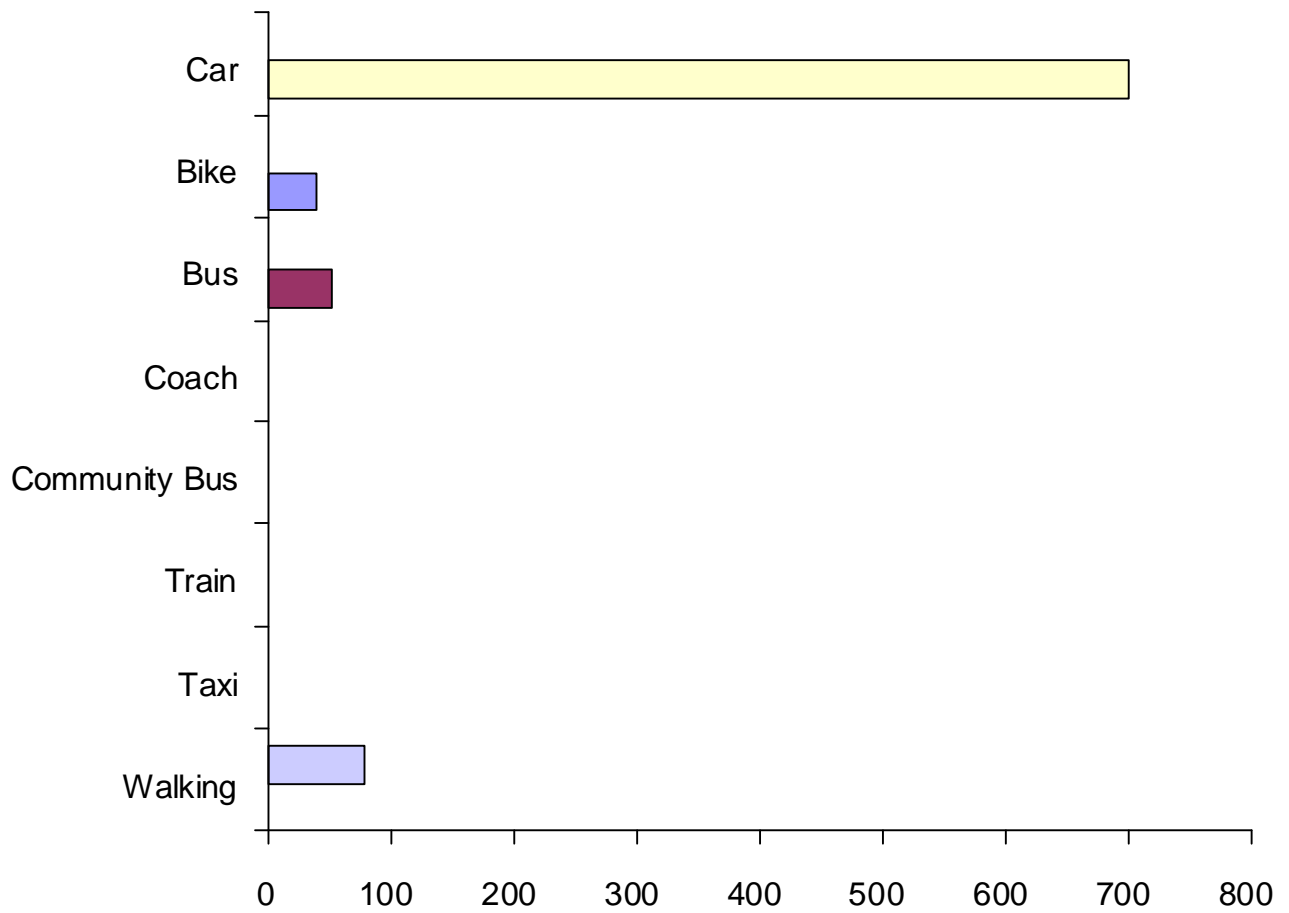
**Q9: Do you share private vehicles with other people, and if so, what for?

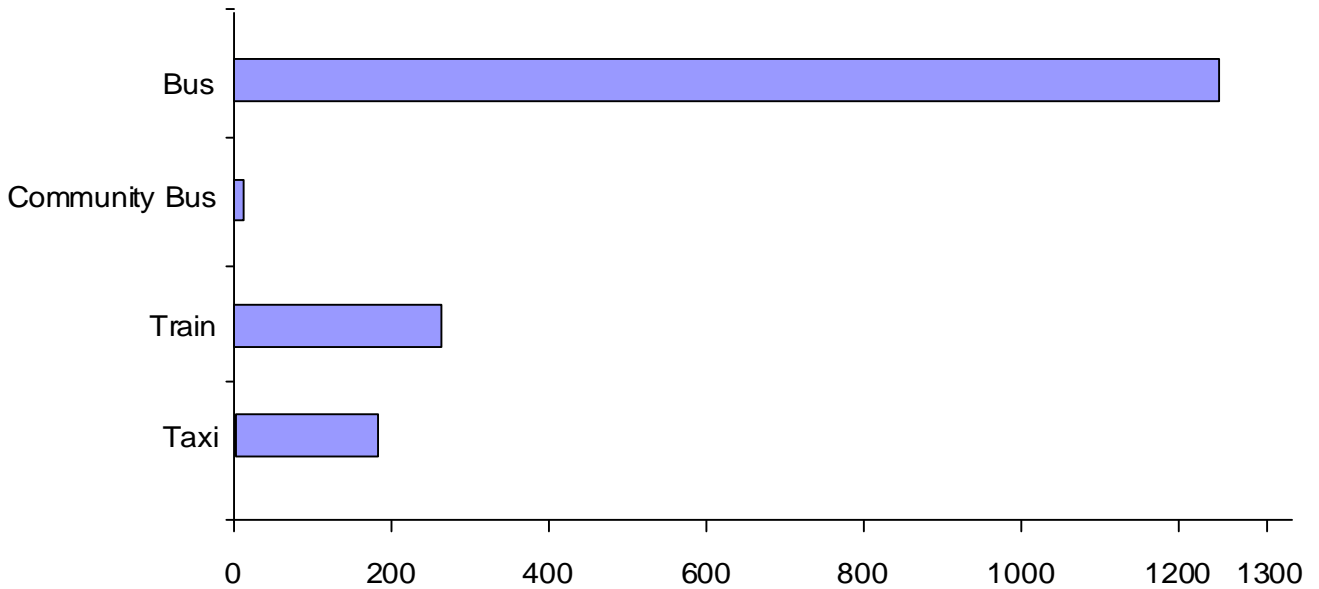
Q10: Which is your main mode of transport?

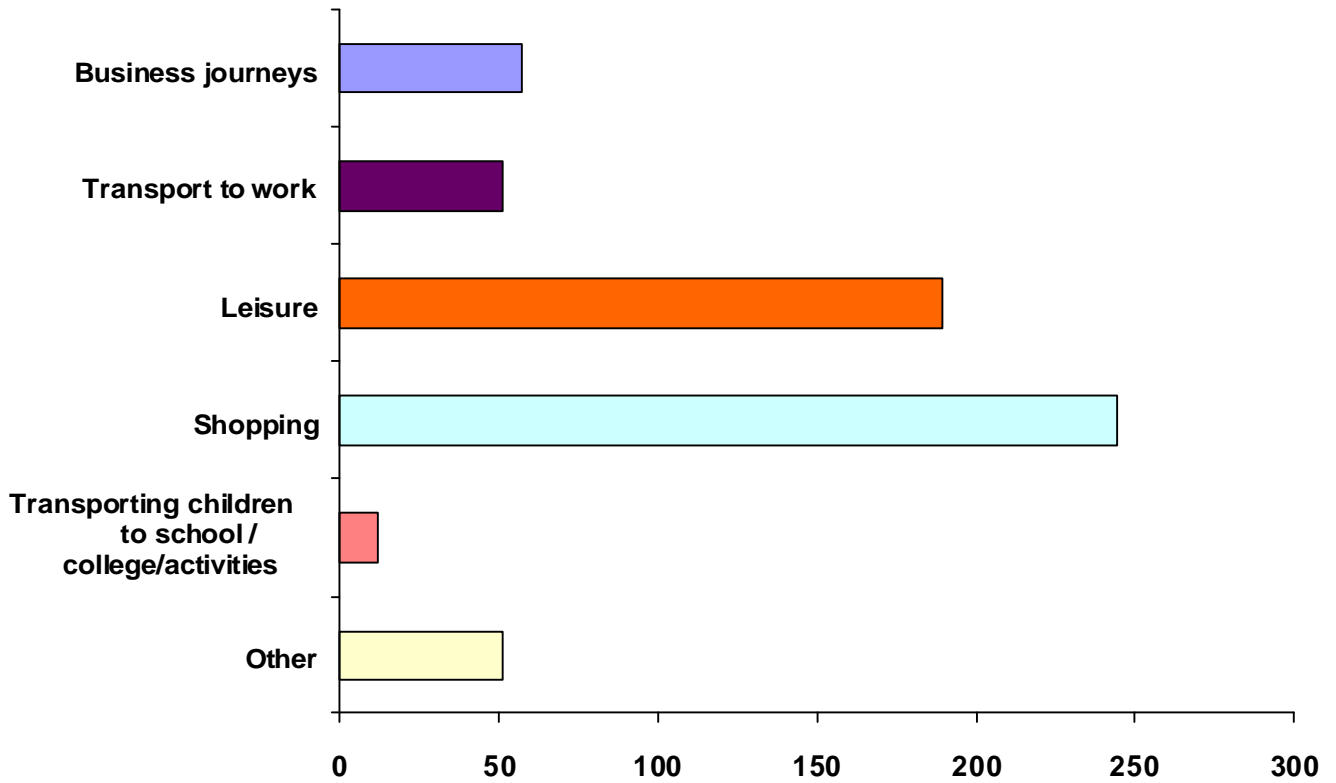
**Q11: If you use these forms of transport, how many times a month, on average, do you use each one?

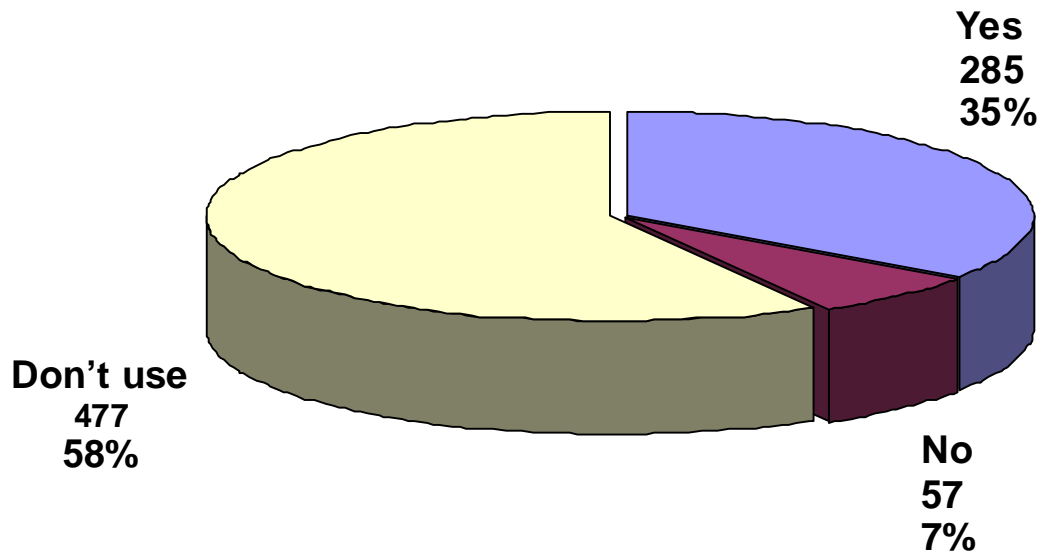
Q12: If you use public transport, which of the following activities do you use it for?

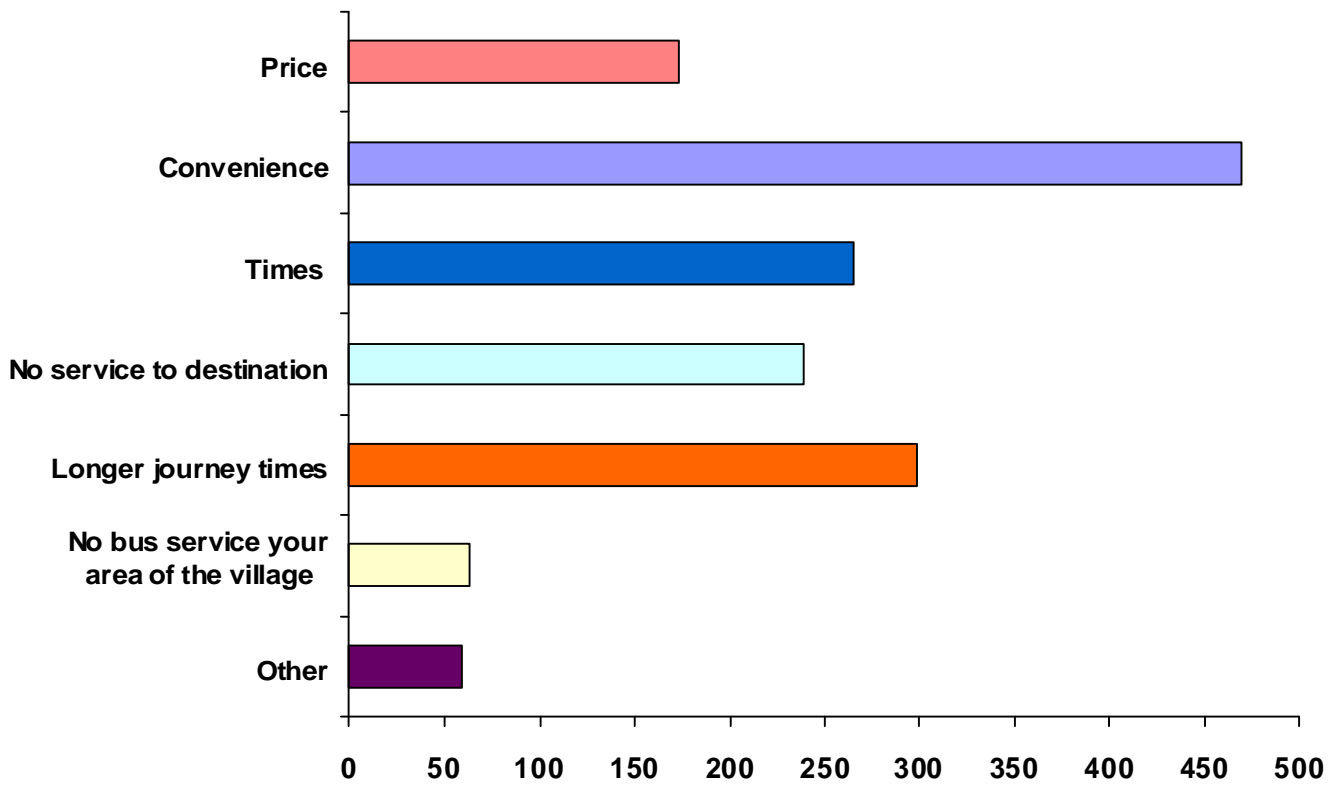
Q13: Are the local taxi services adequate for your requirements?

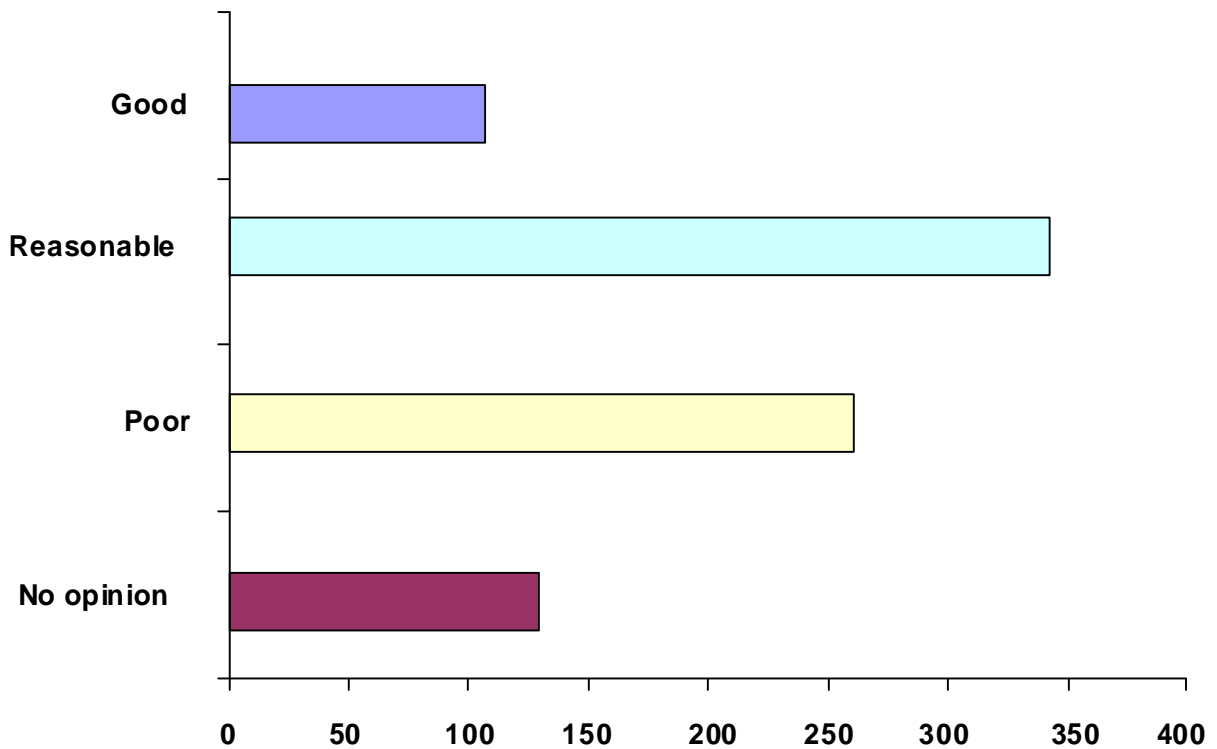
Q14: If you do not use public transport, why not?

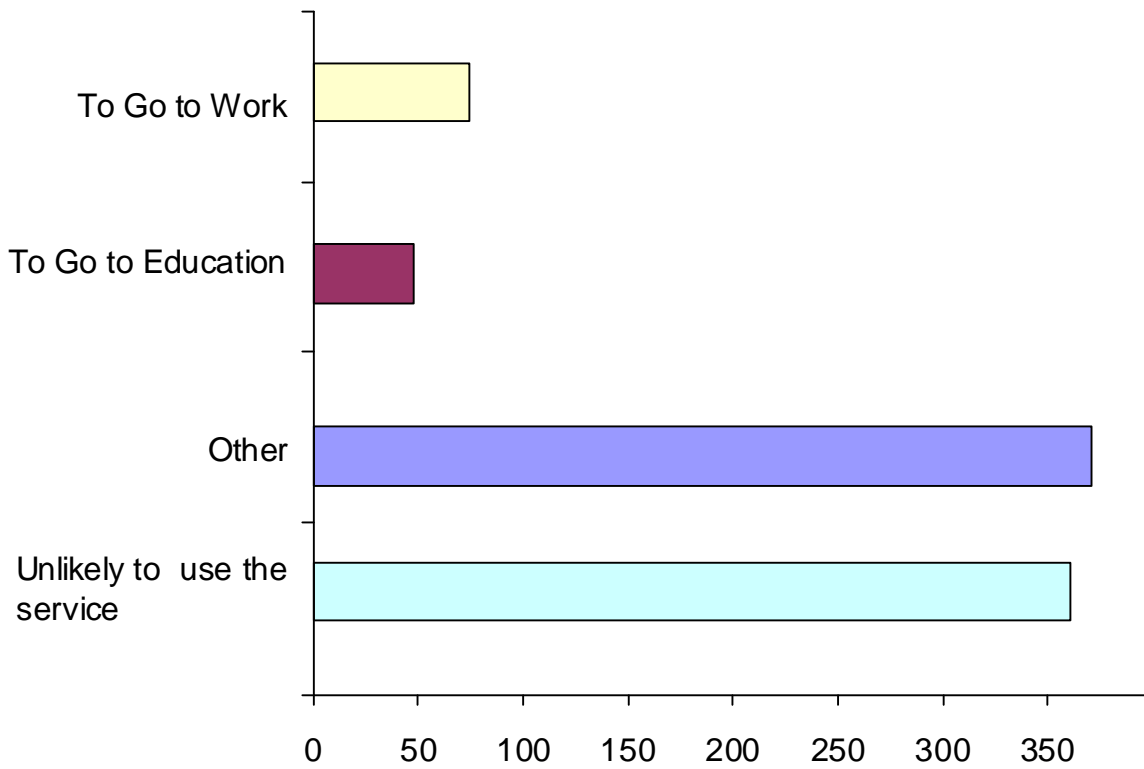
Q15: How do you rate the facilities for cyclists in and around Swavesey?

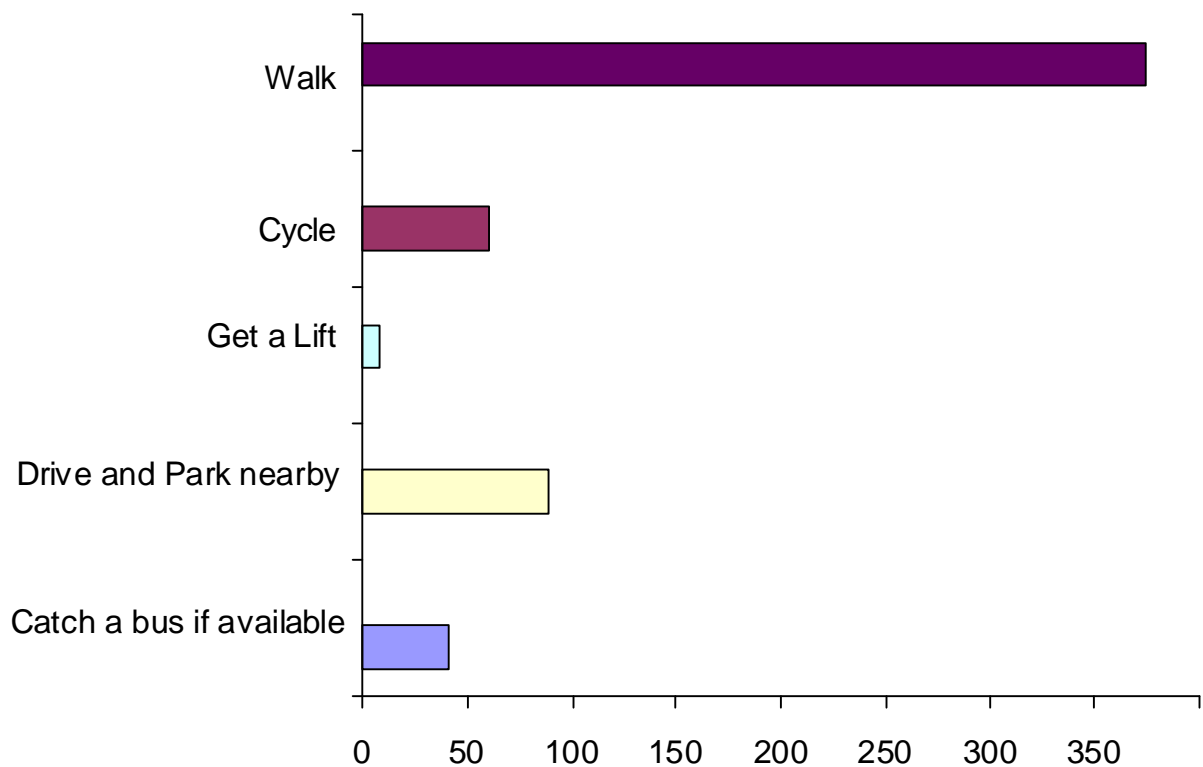
Q16: Do think you will use the Guided Bus when it is commissioned

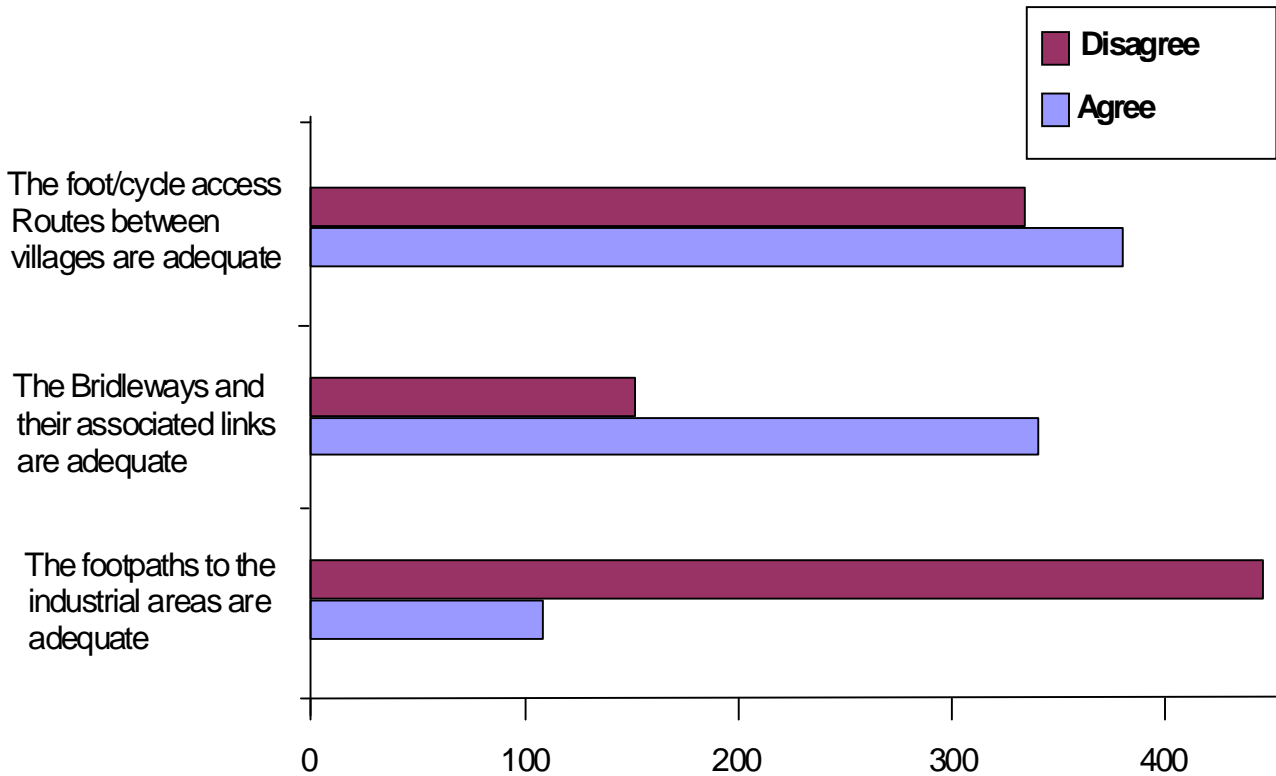
Q17: If you intend to use the Guided Bus how will you get to the Guided bus Stop

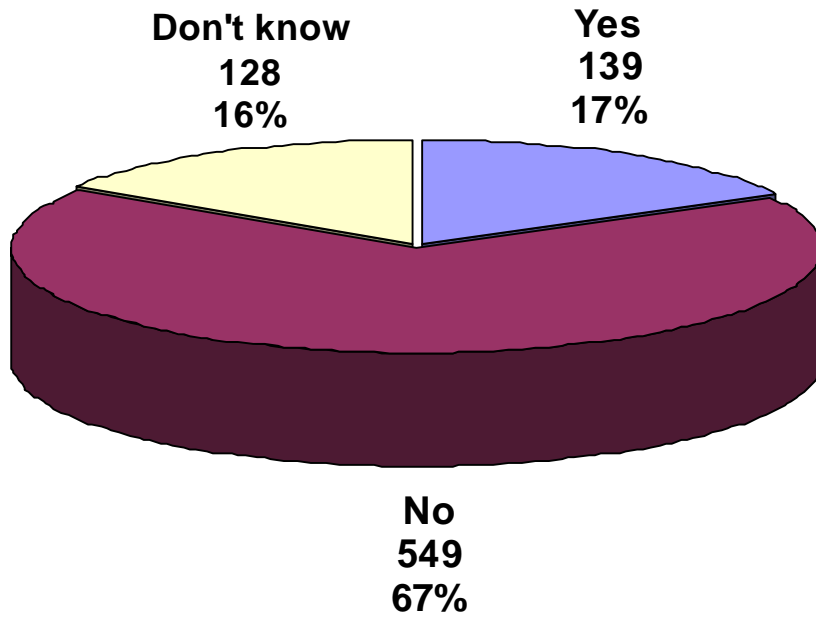

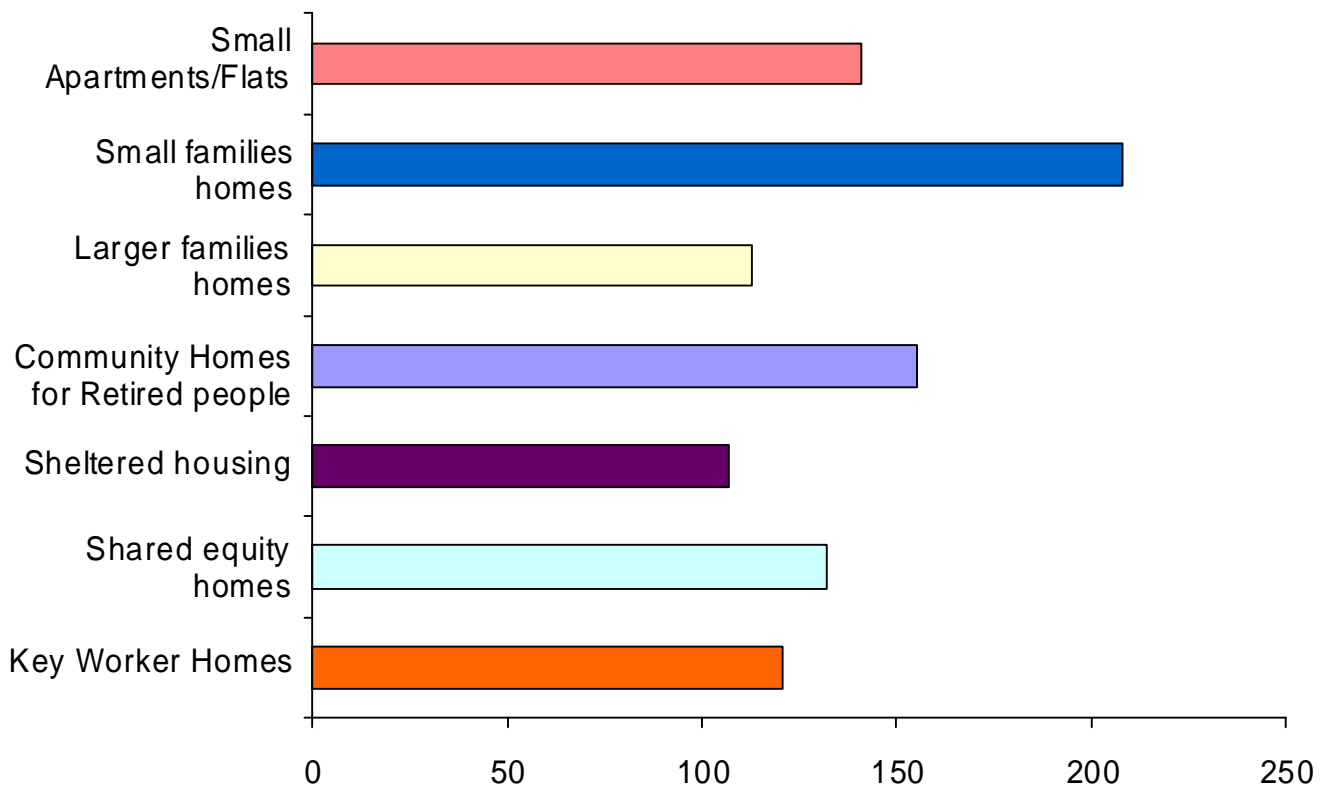
Q20: Do you think Swavesey can accommodate more new housing?

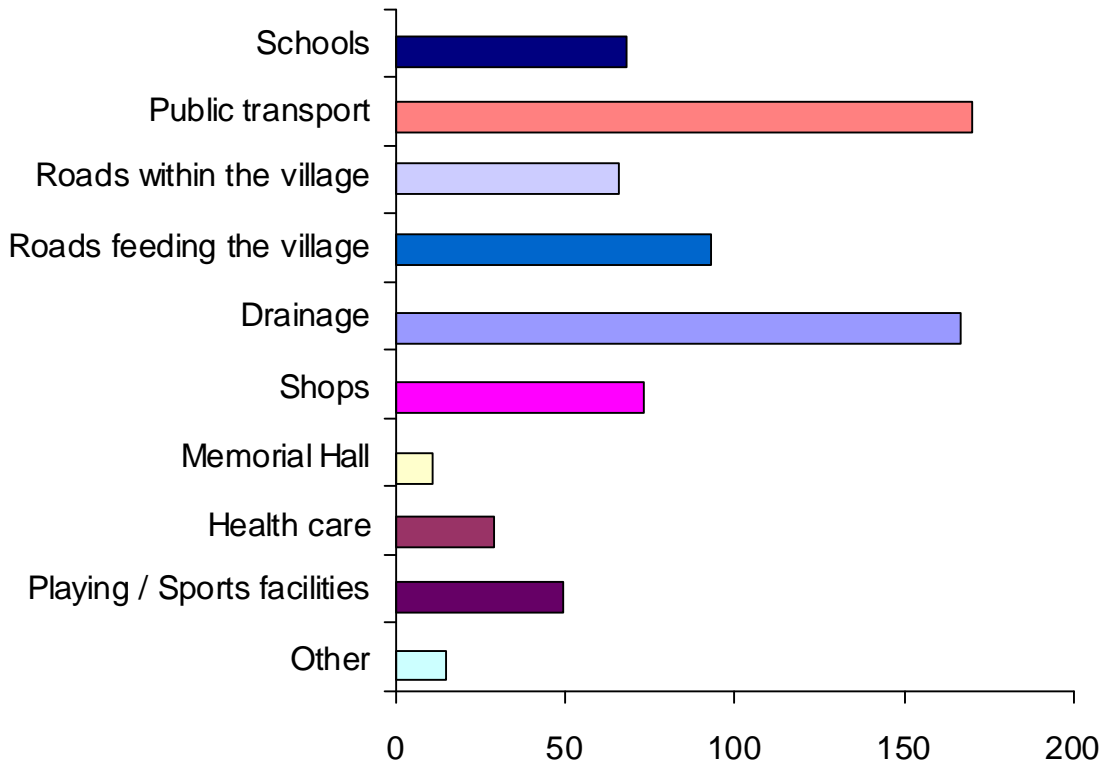

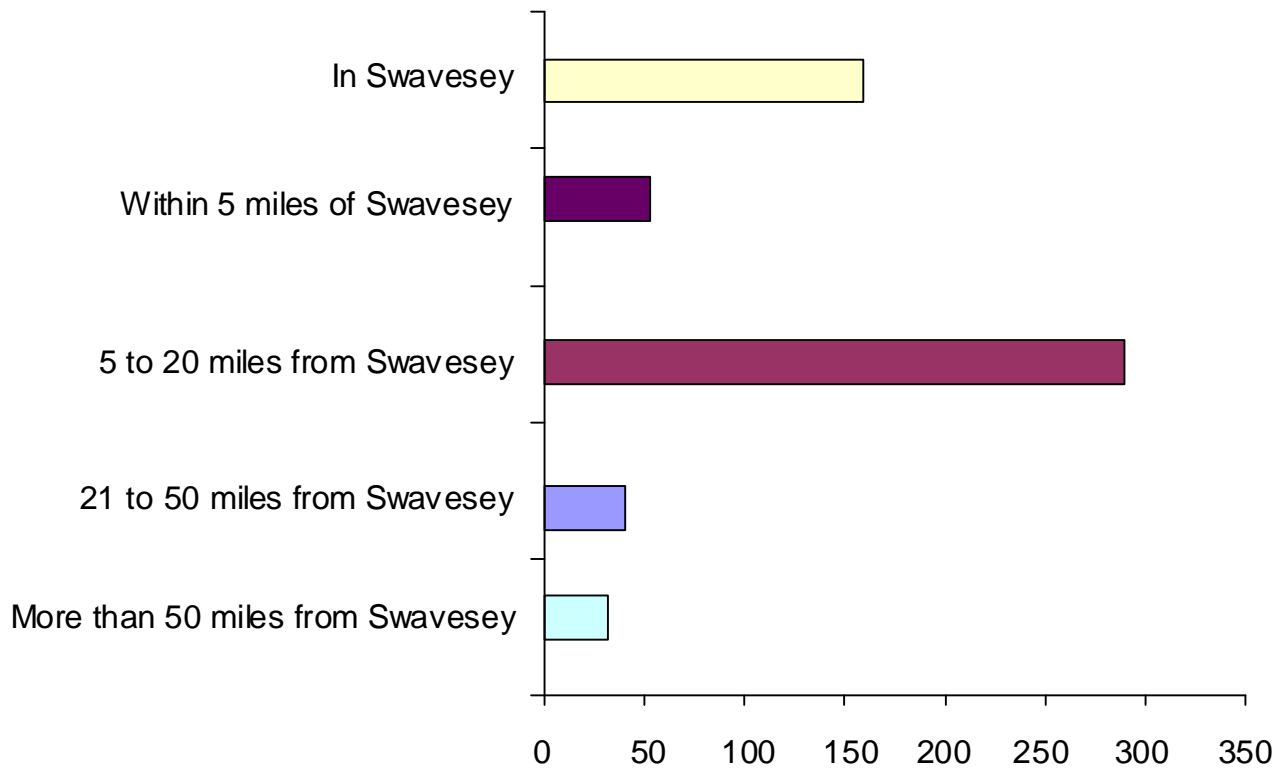
**Q22: If new housing was to be developed in Swavesey, which service do you consider is most in need of improvement?

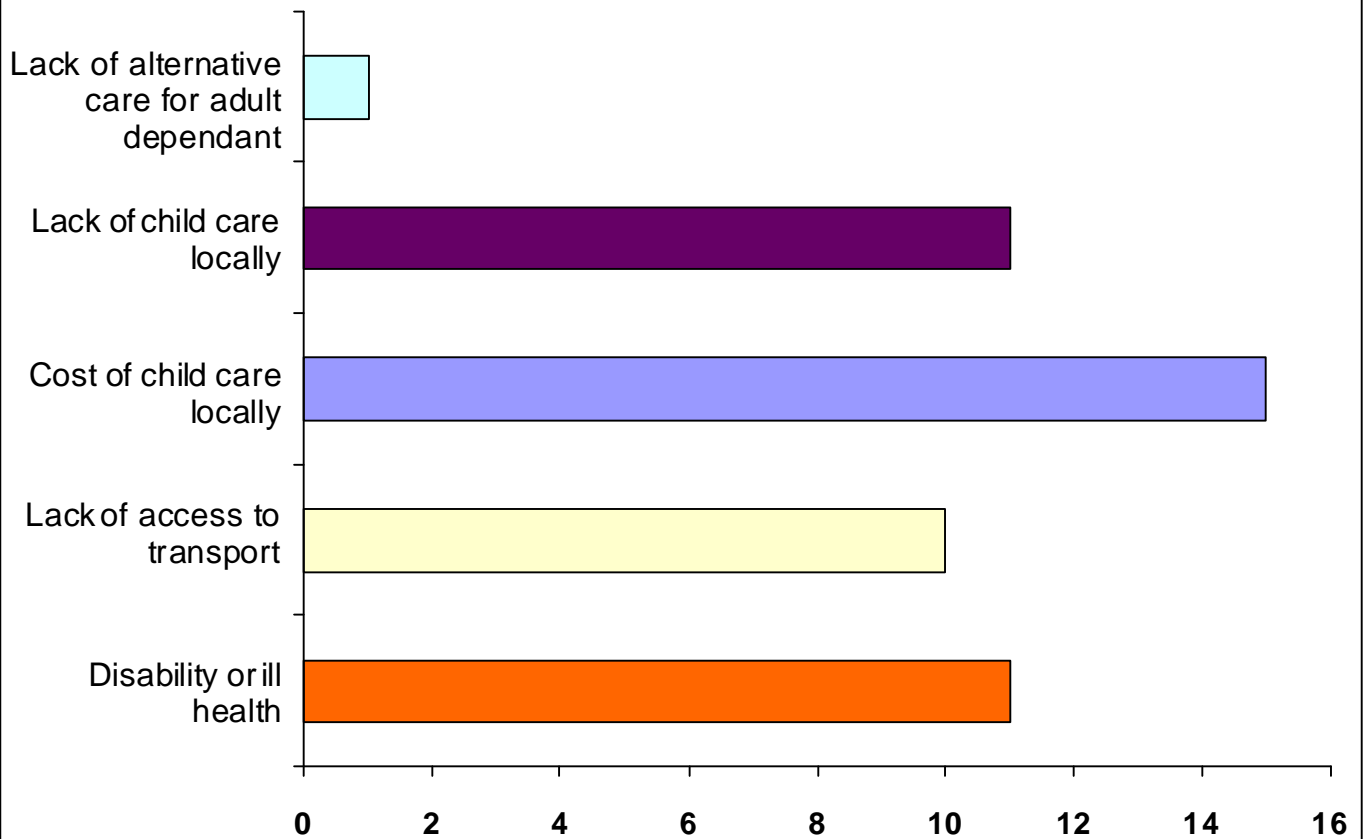
Q23: Where is your main place of work?

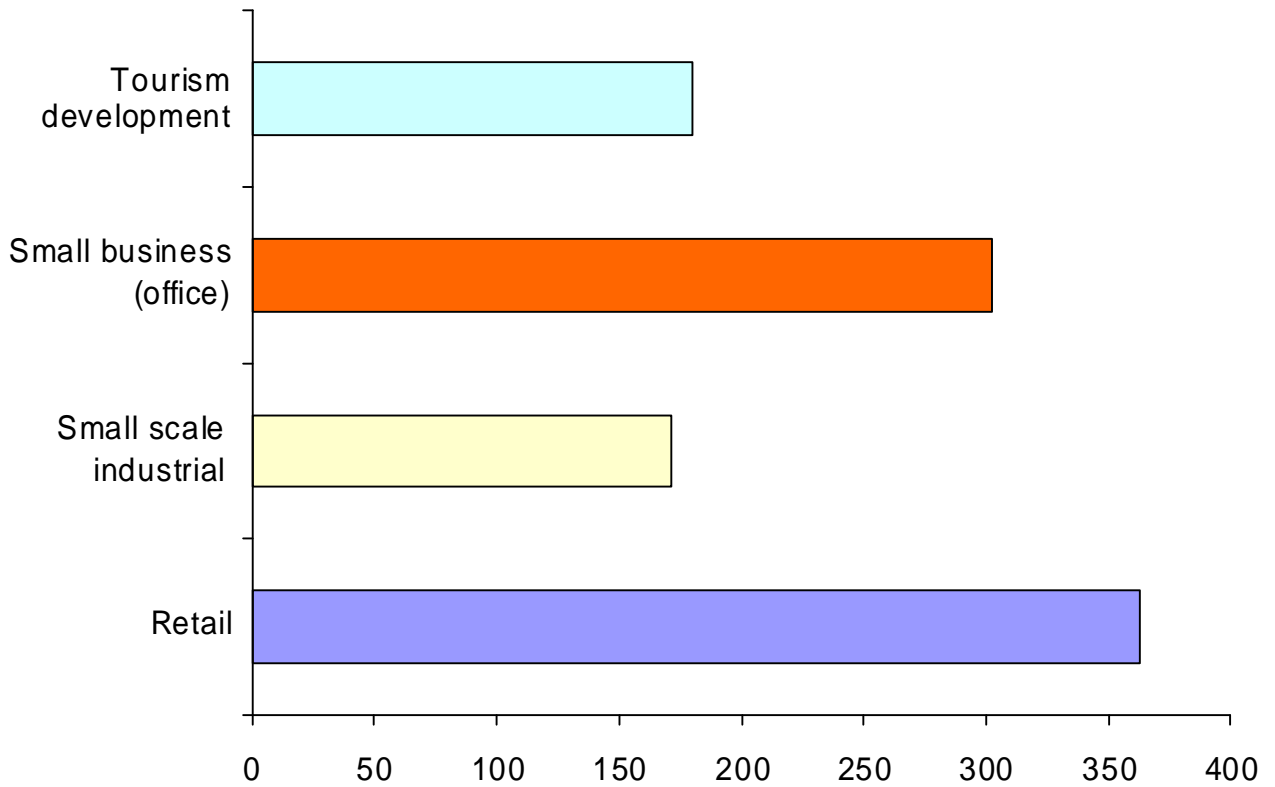

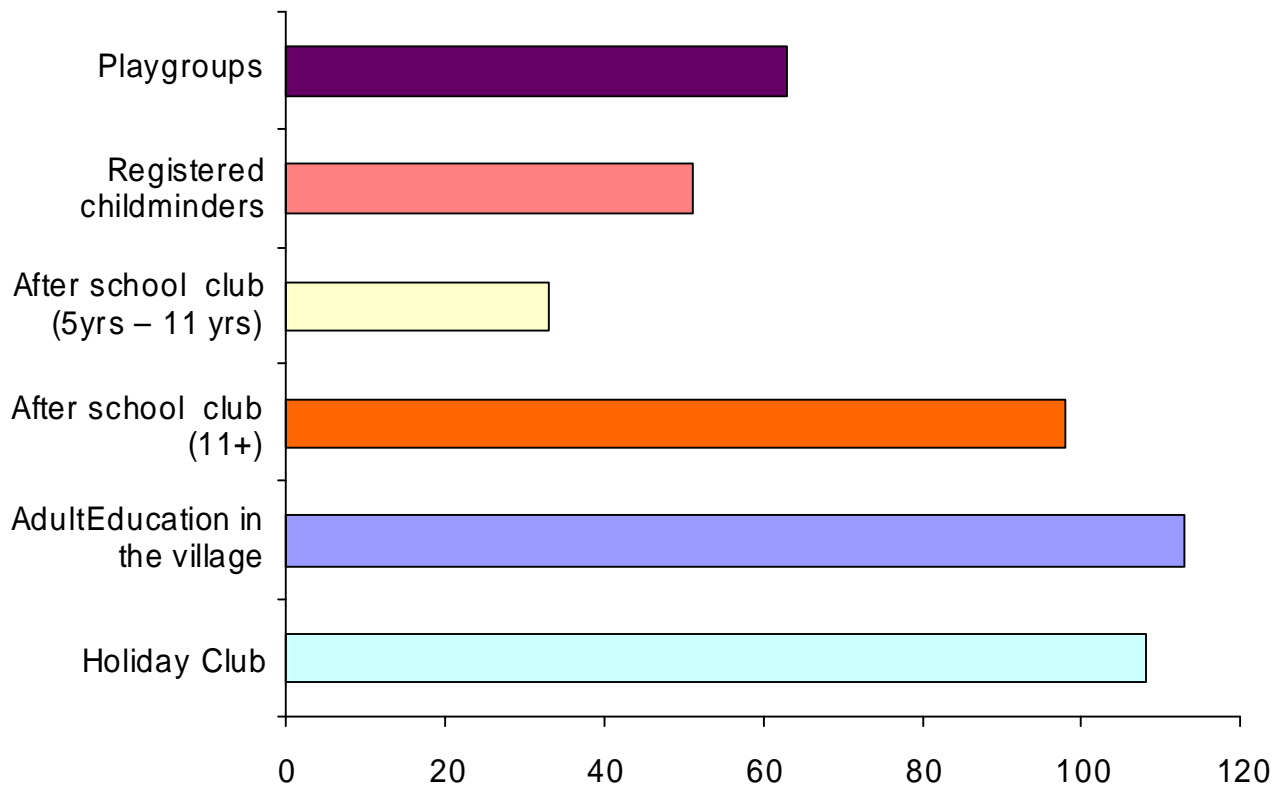
**Q25: In the right location, should the following be encouraged in and around Swavesey?

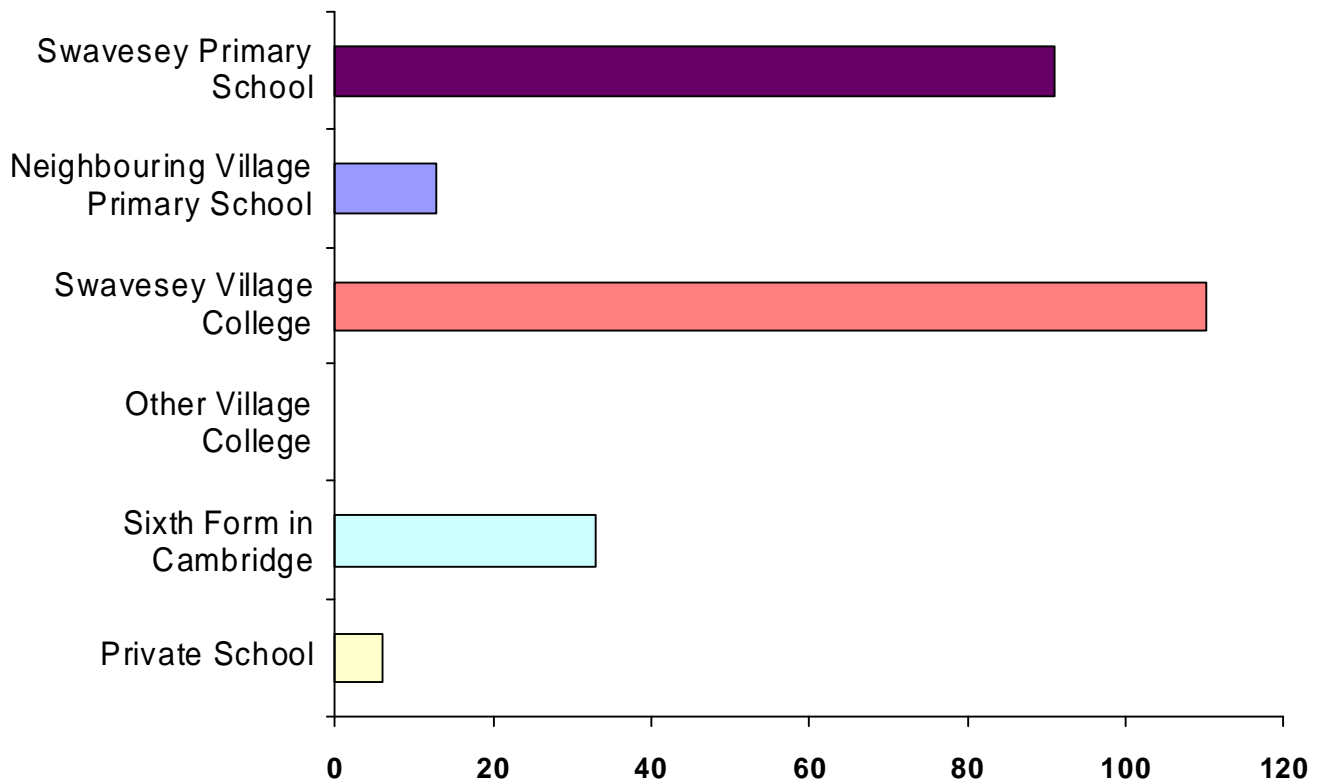
Q27: Do you feel Swavesey needs more of the following?

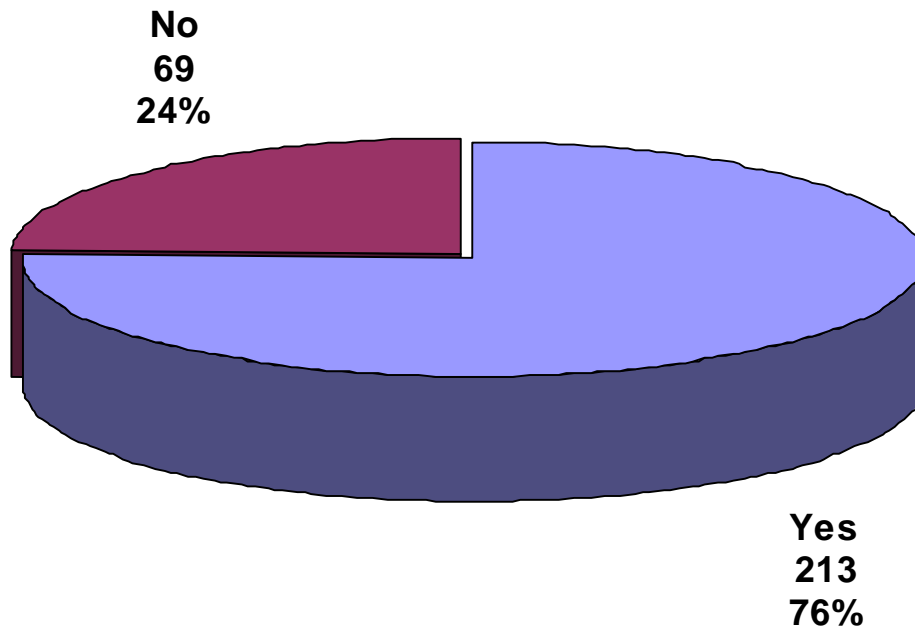
Q28: Which Schools do your children attend?

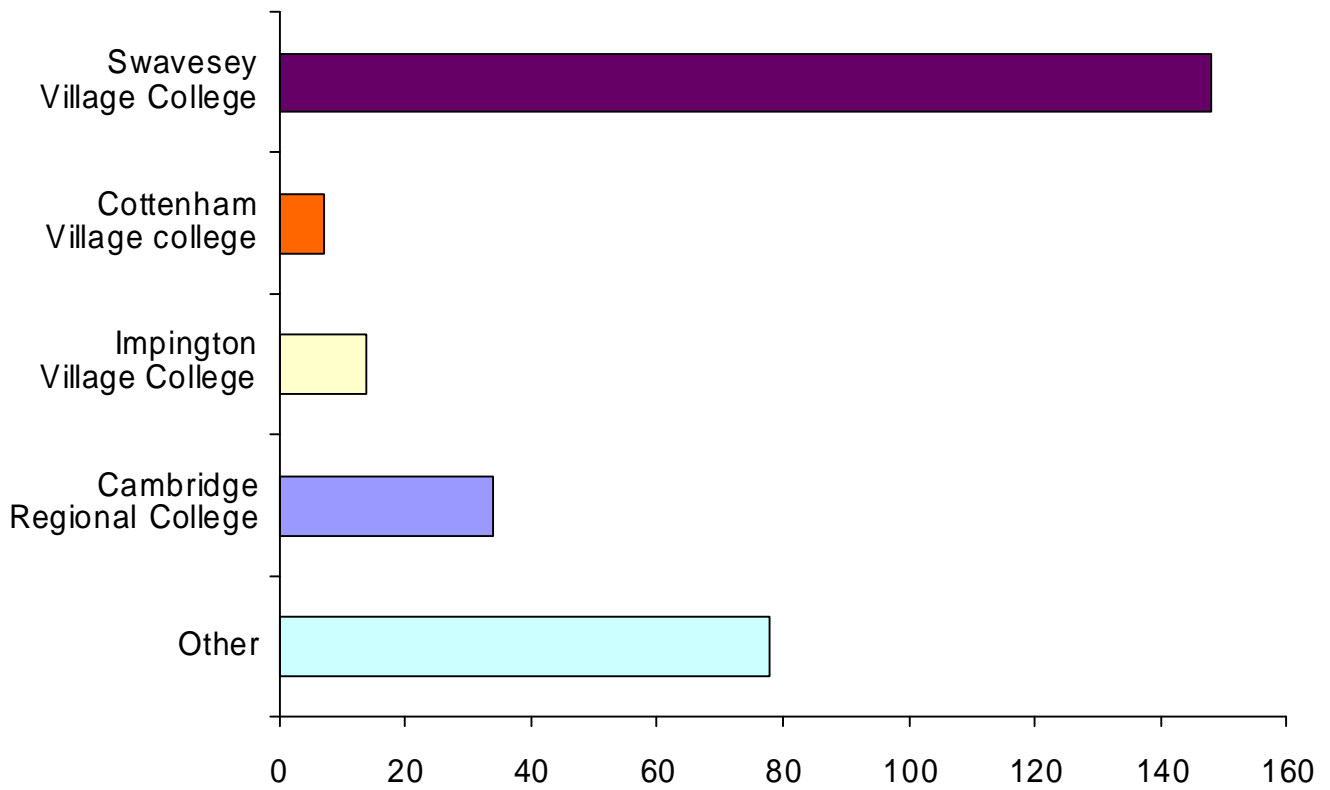

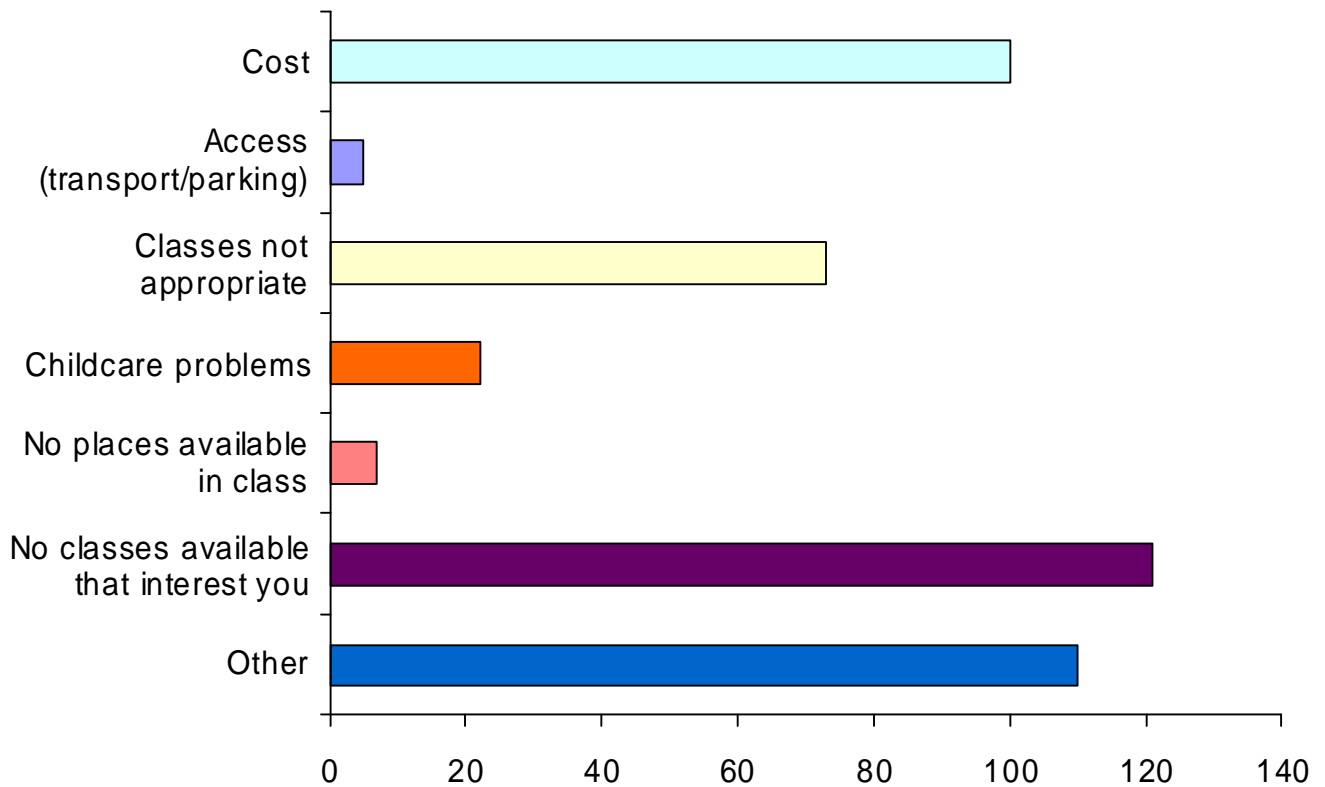
Q30: Where do you go for adult education?

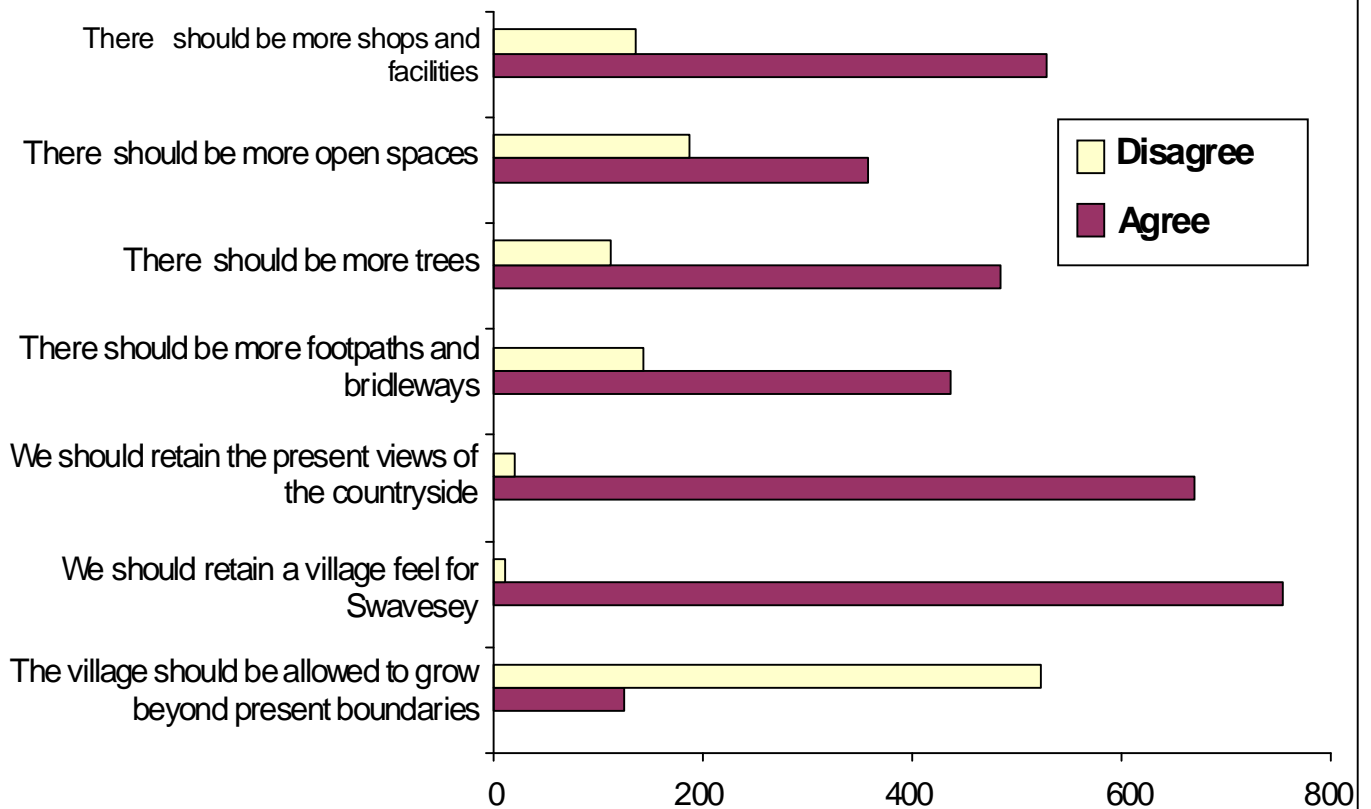

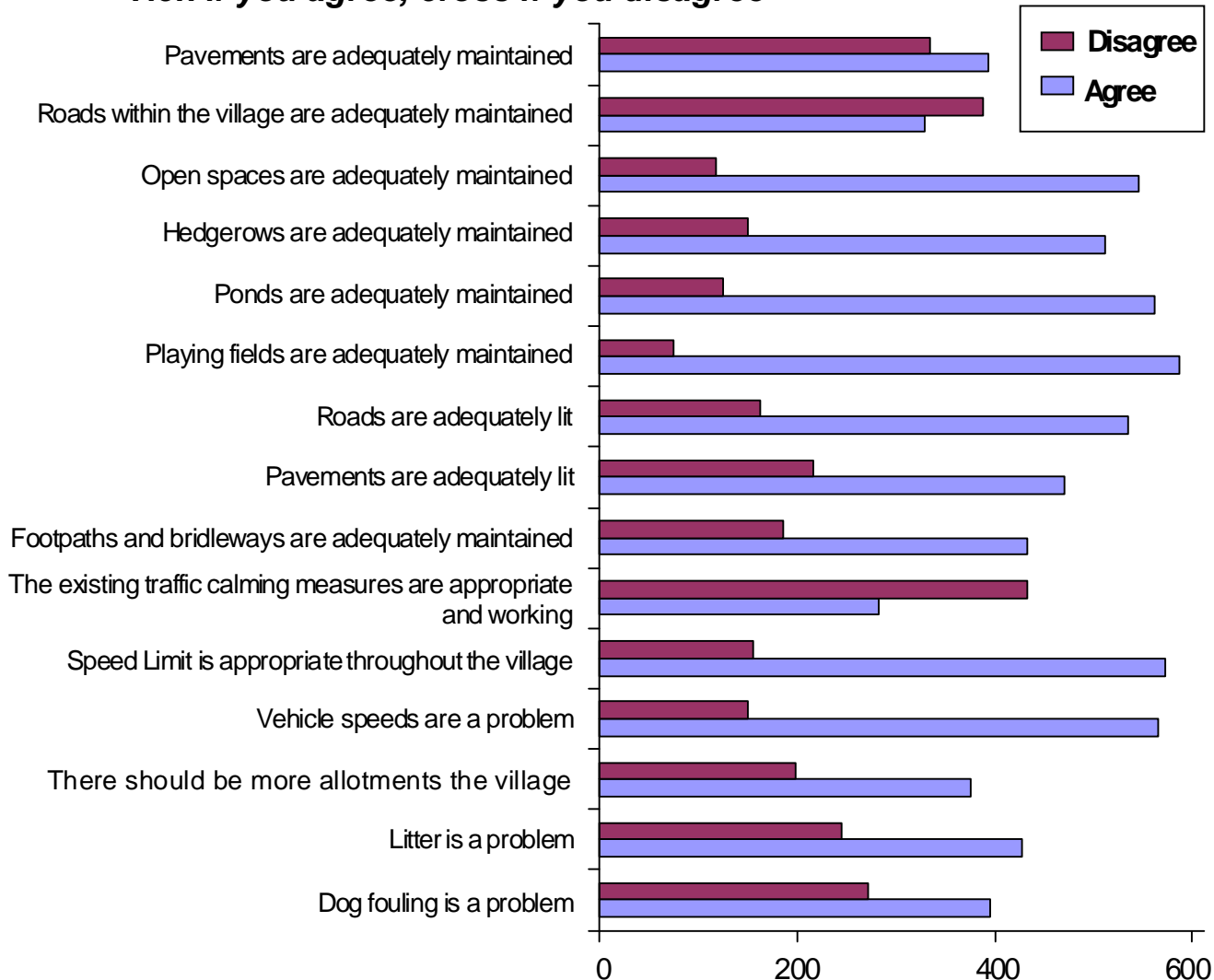

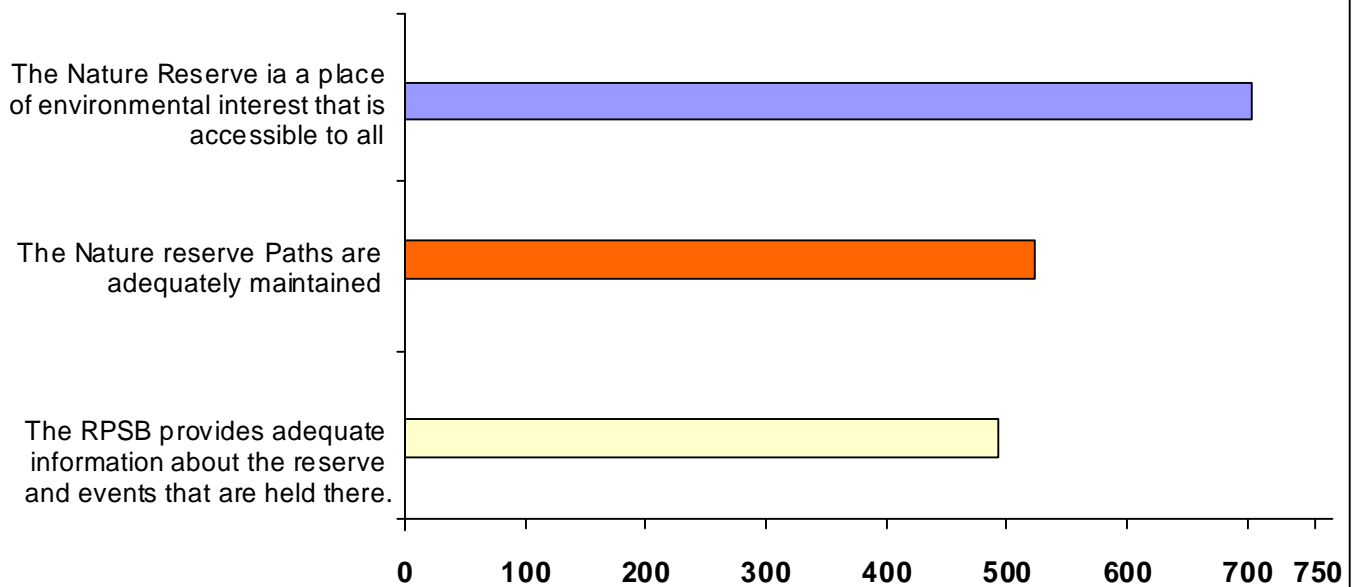

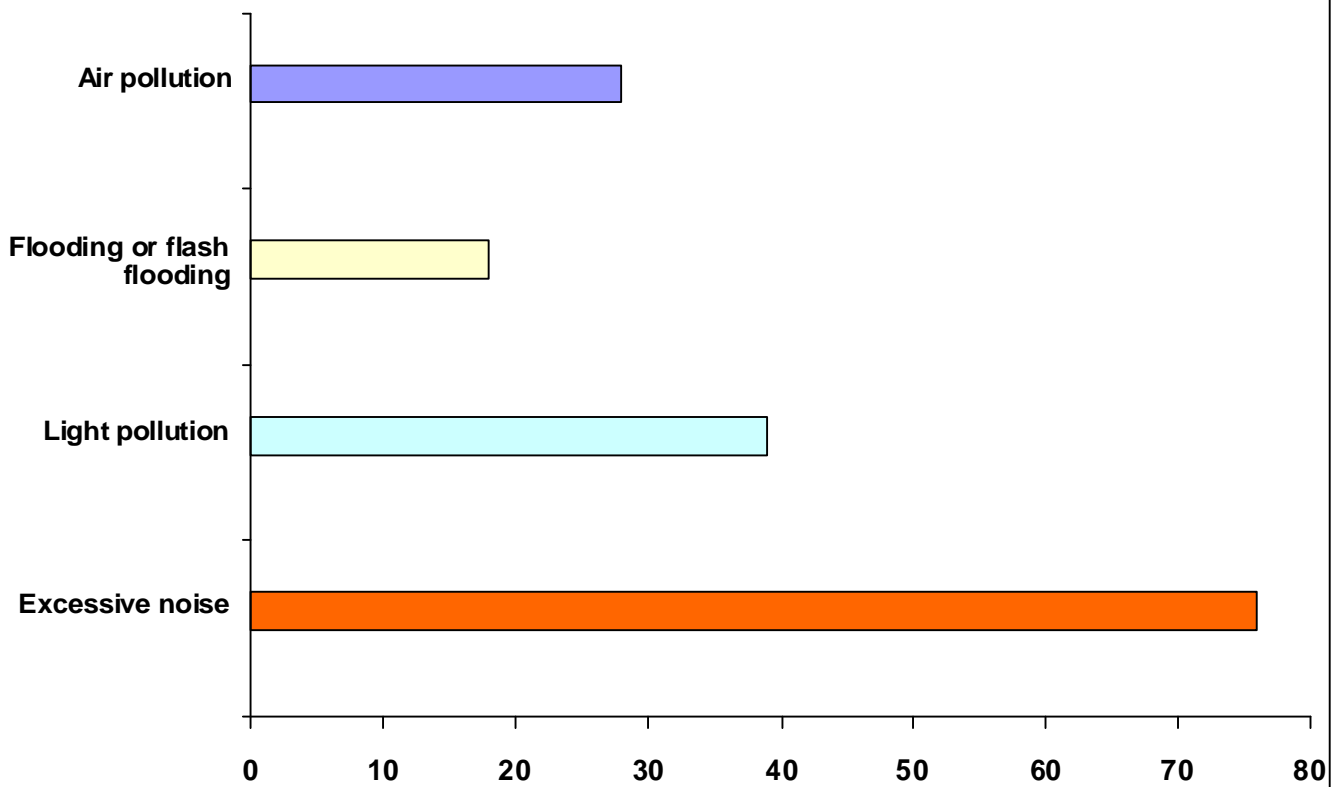

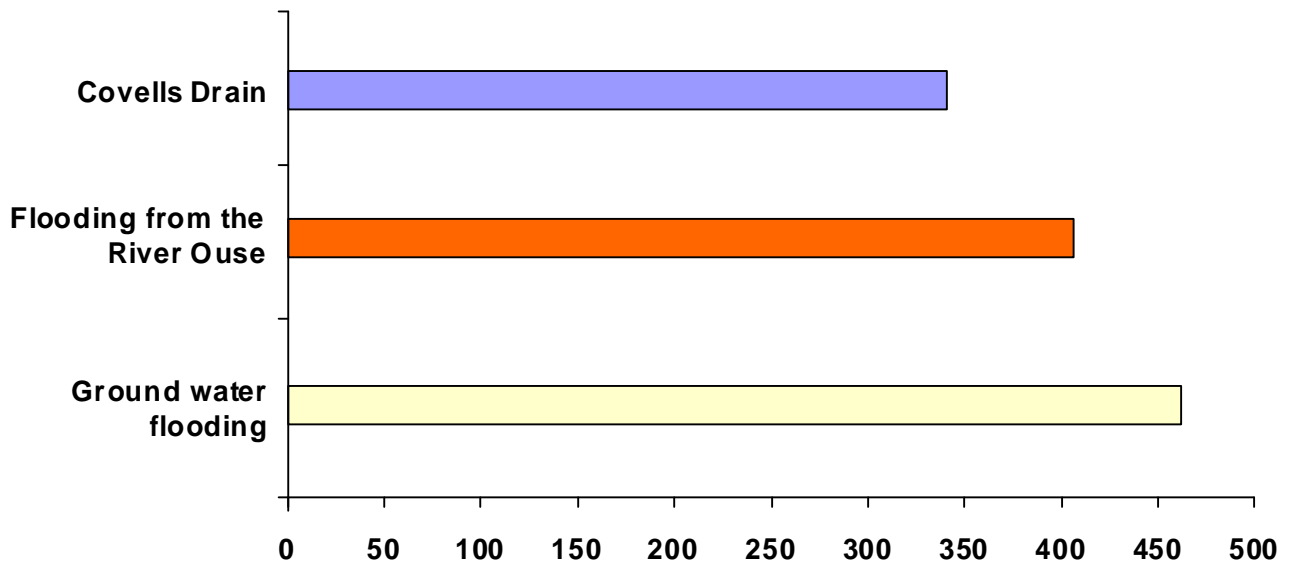

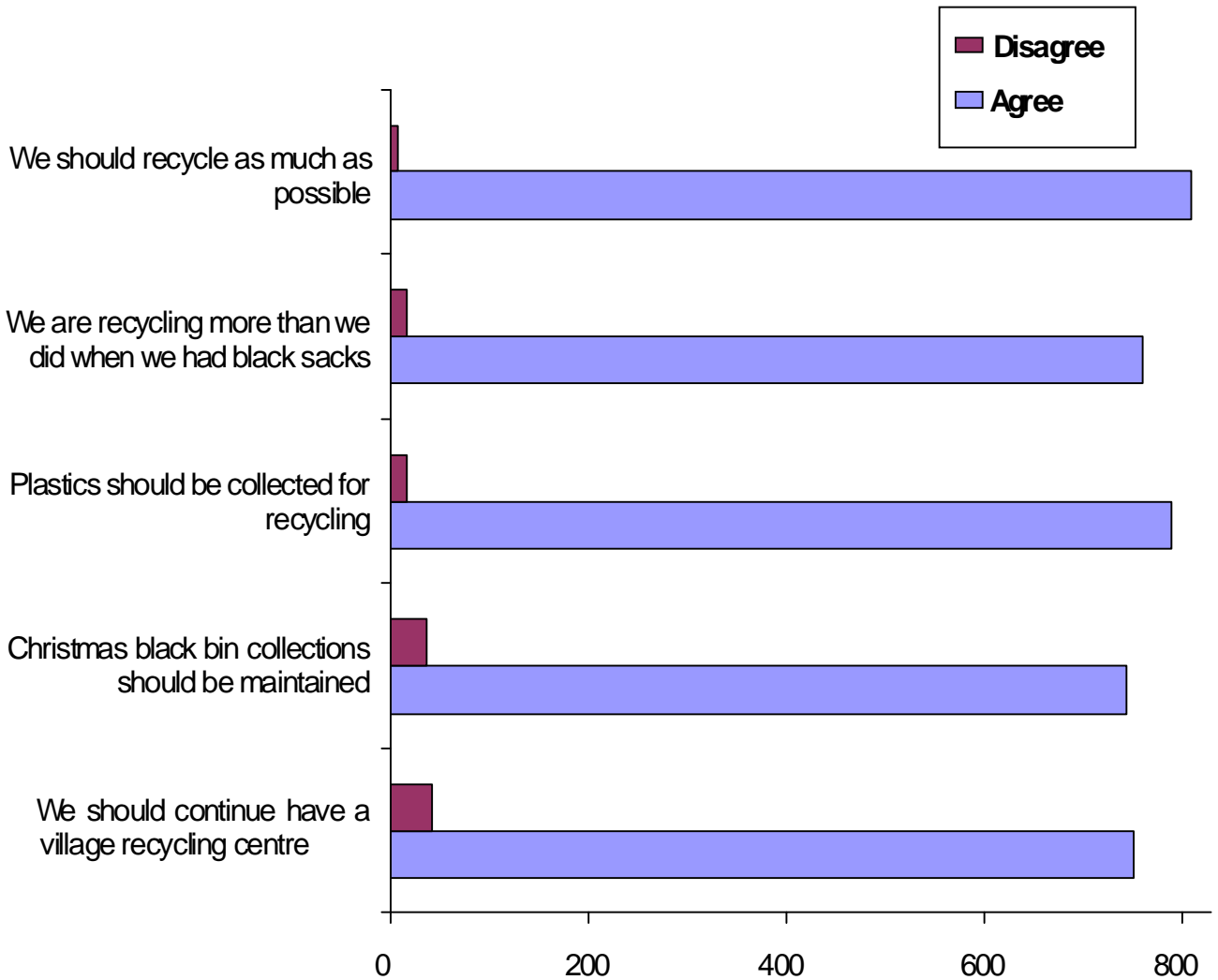

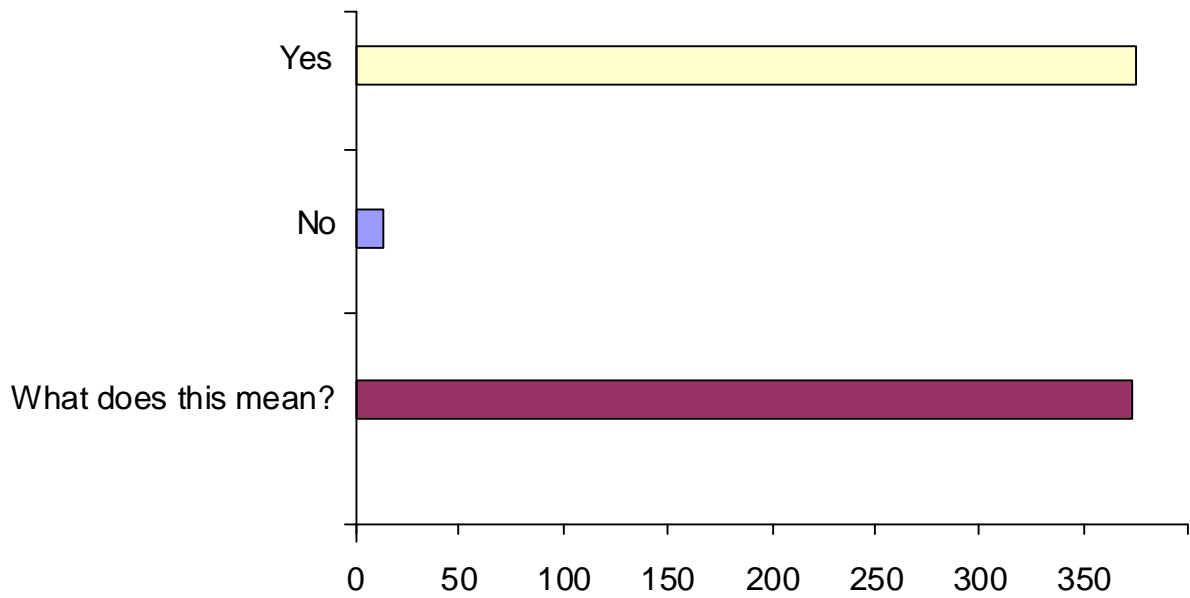

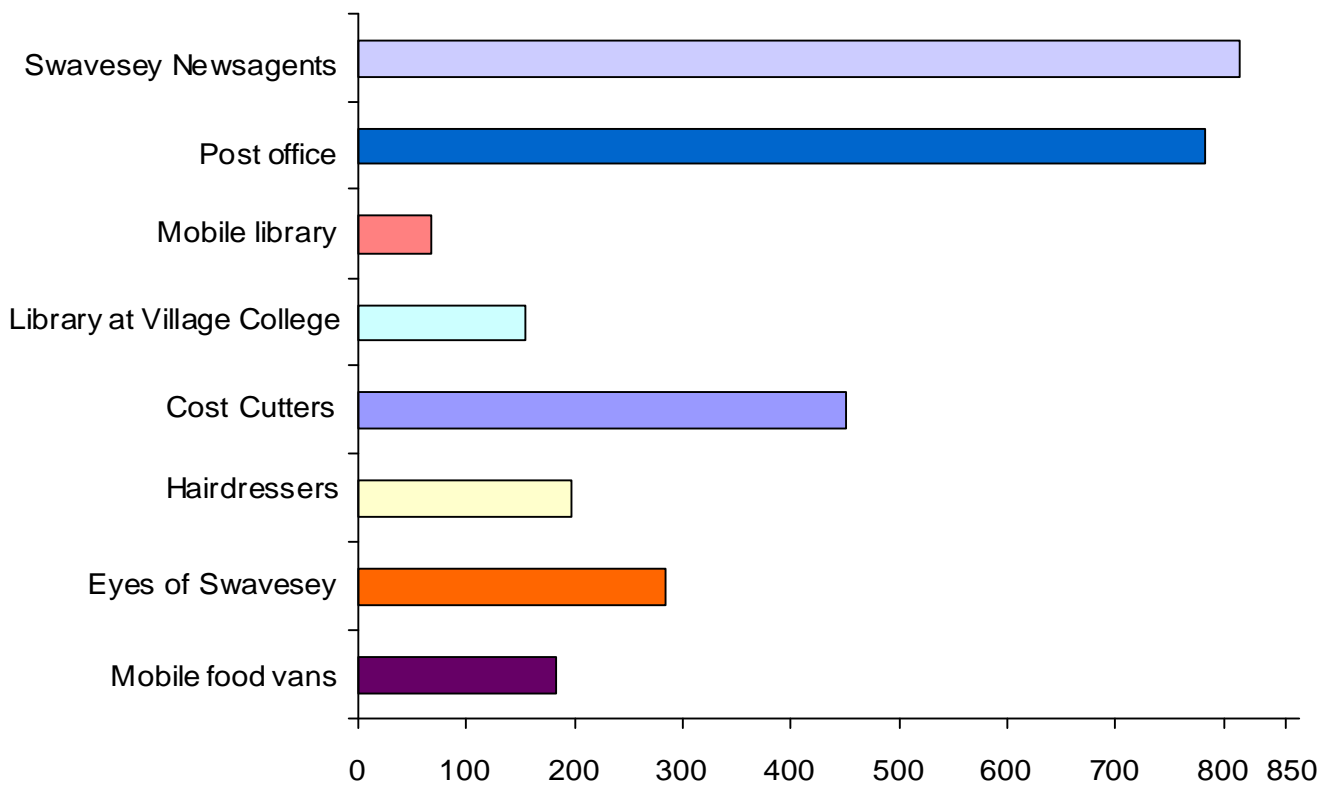

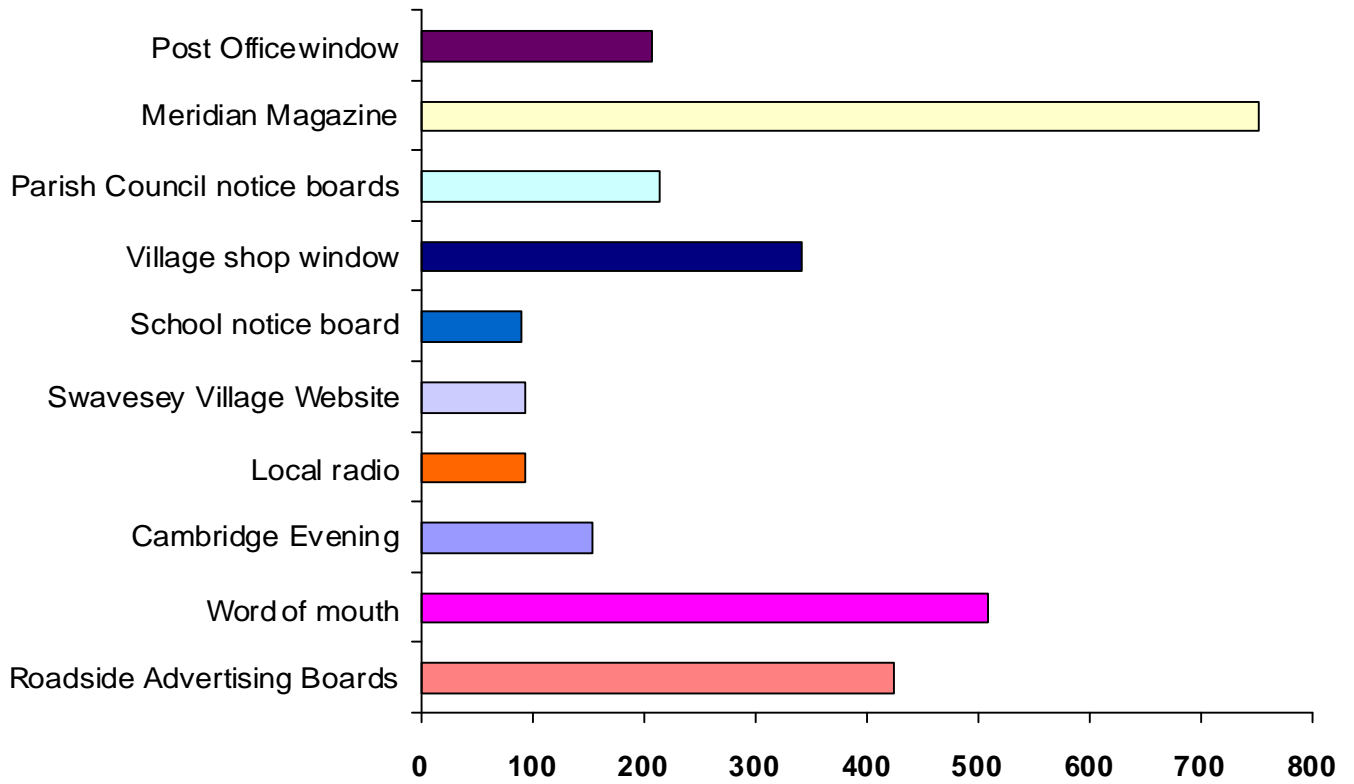

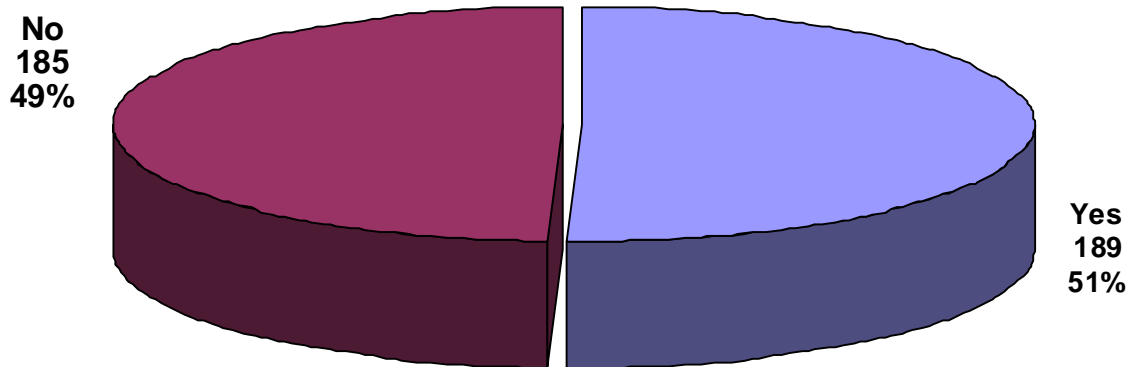
Q46: Where do you usually get information about events taking place in Swavesey?

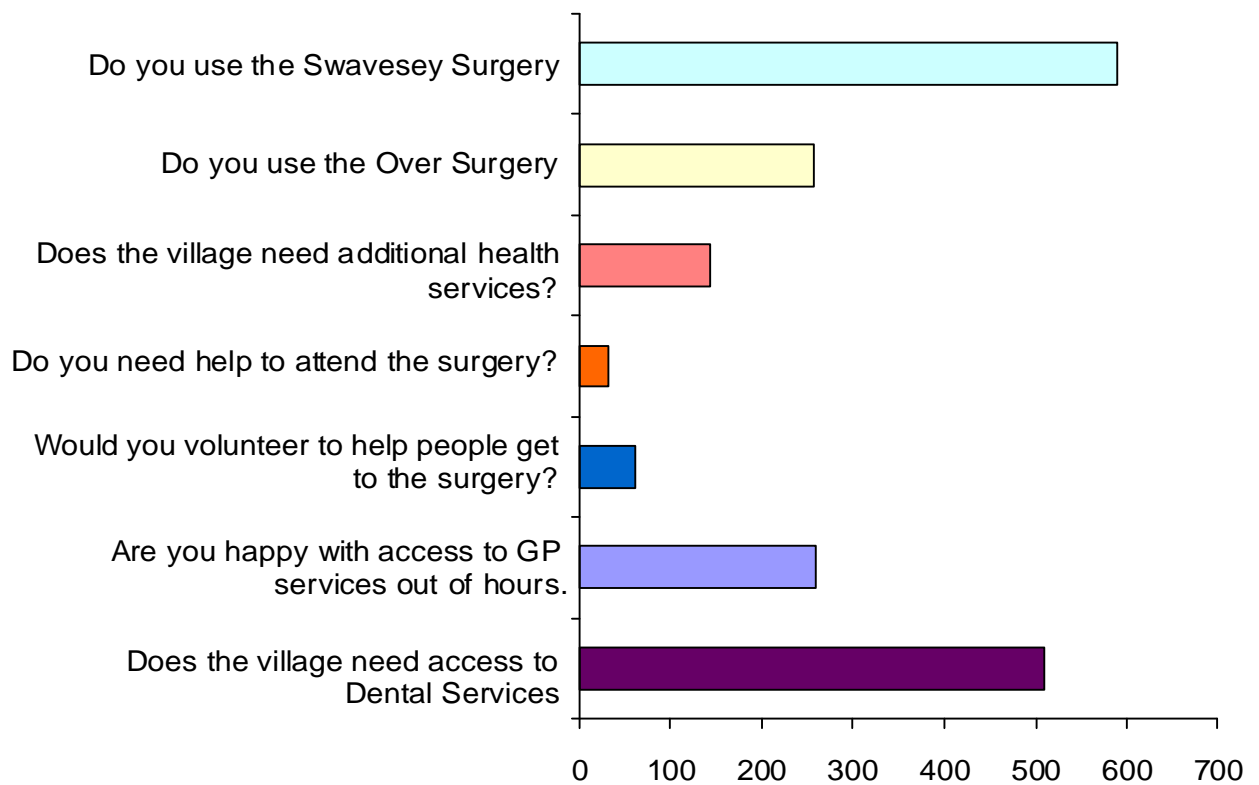

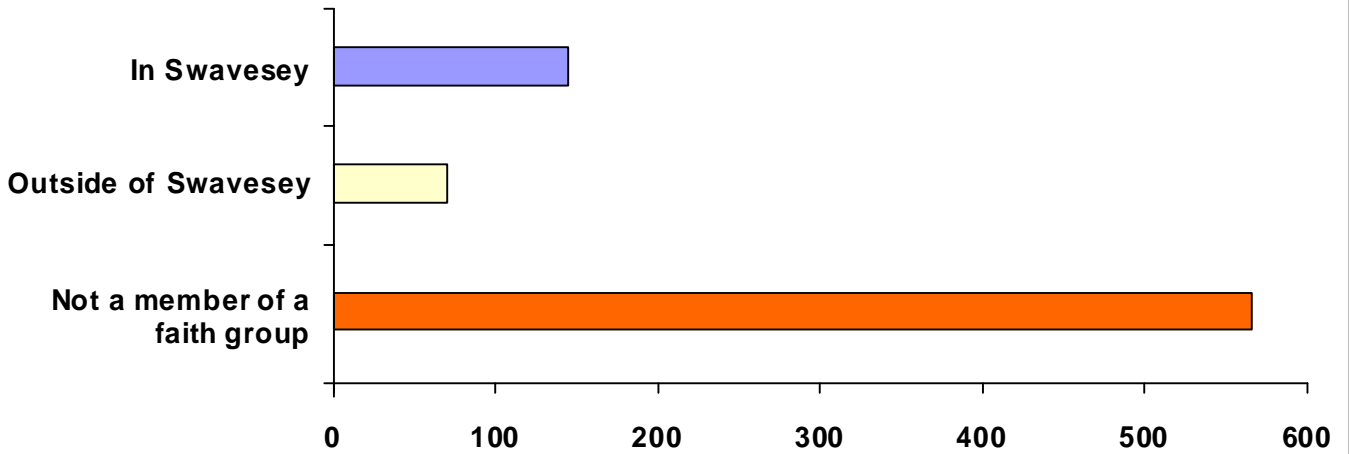

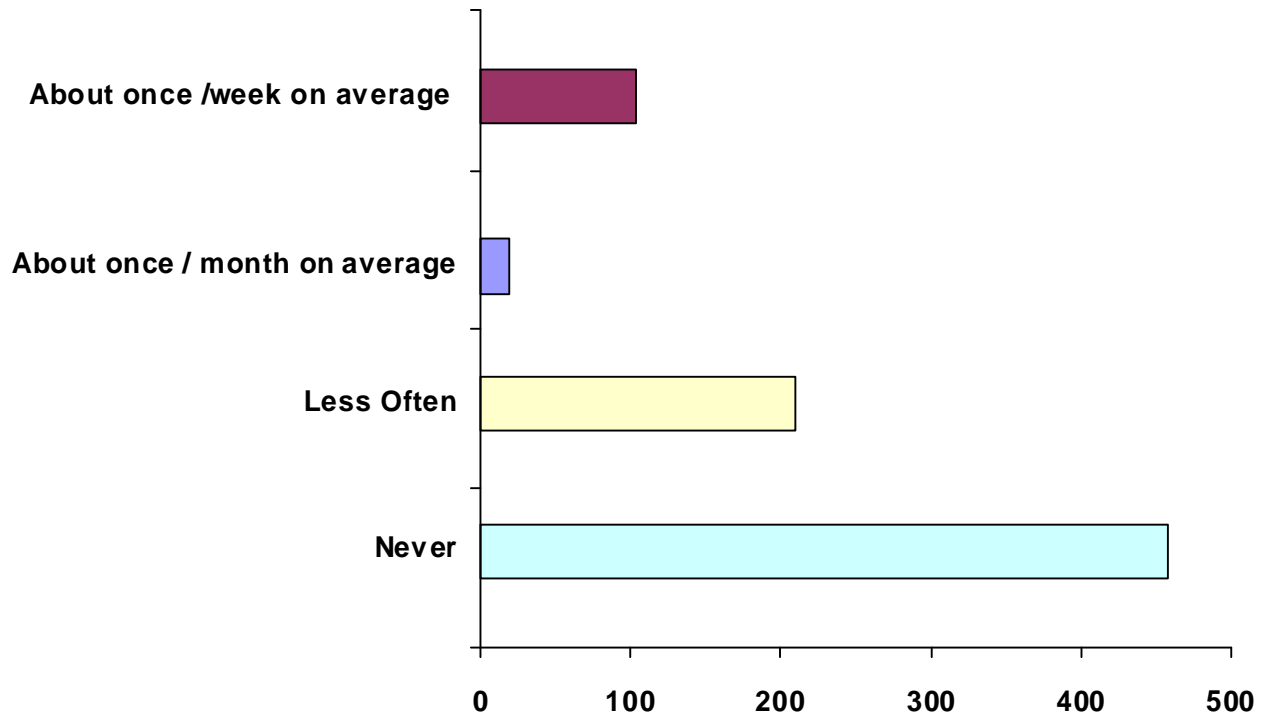

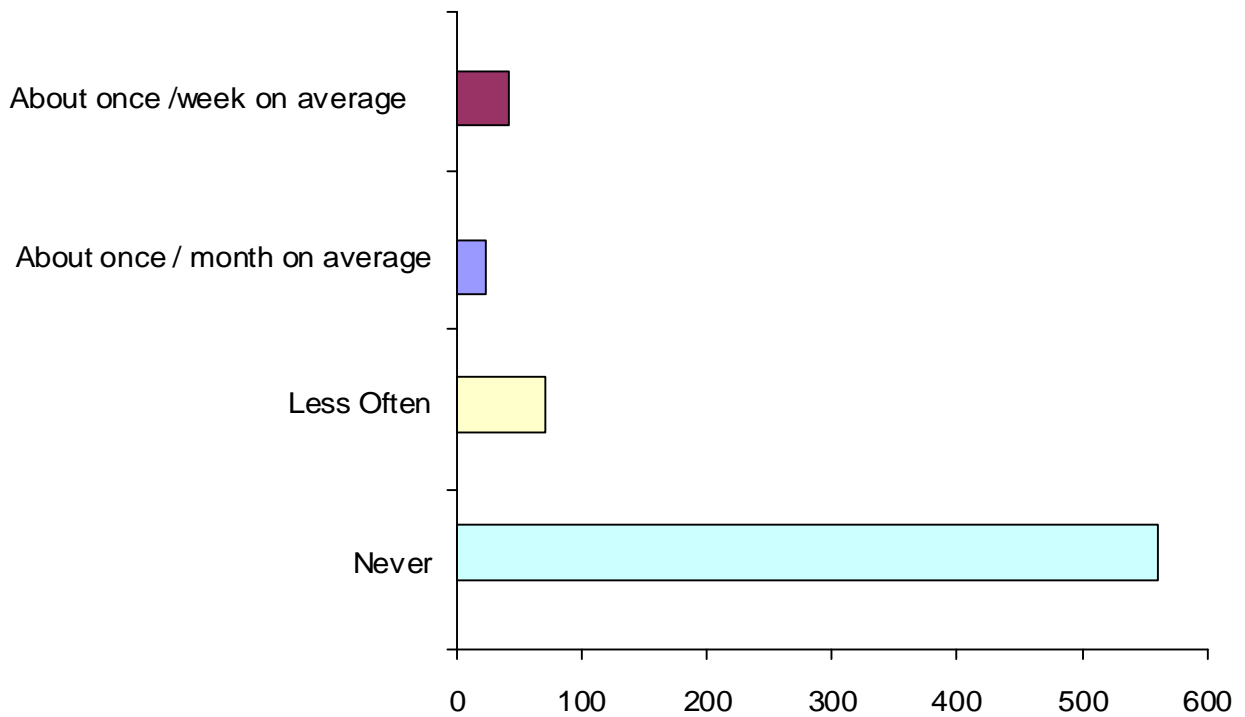
Q51: How often do you attend any of the three Churches in Swavesey

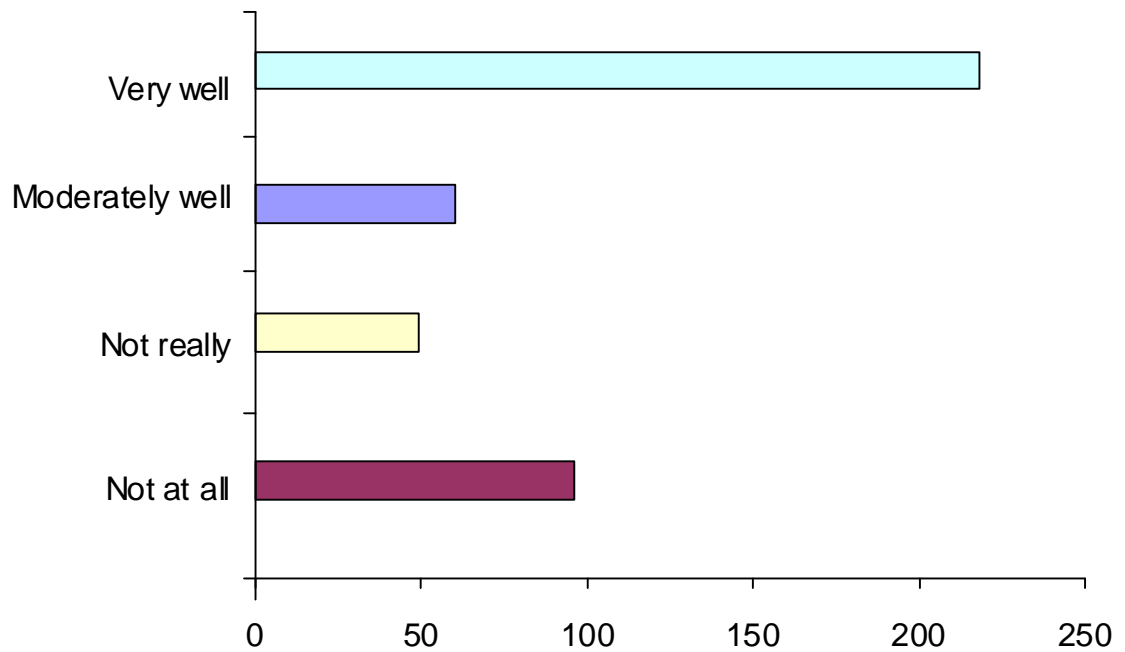
Q52: Do you attend a faith group somewhere other than in Swavesey

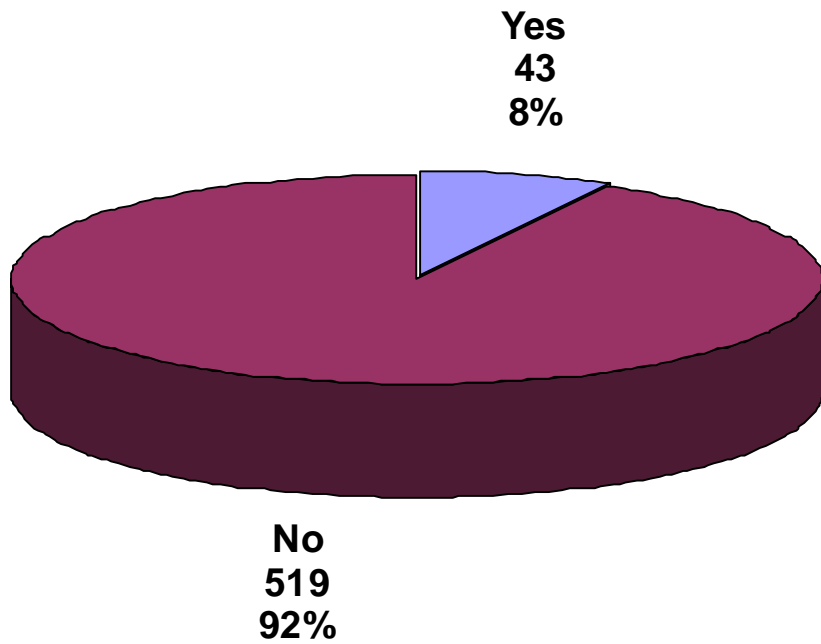
Q53: Do the three Churches in Swavesey meet your needs as places of worship?

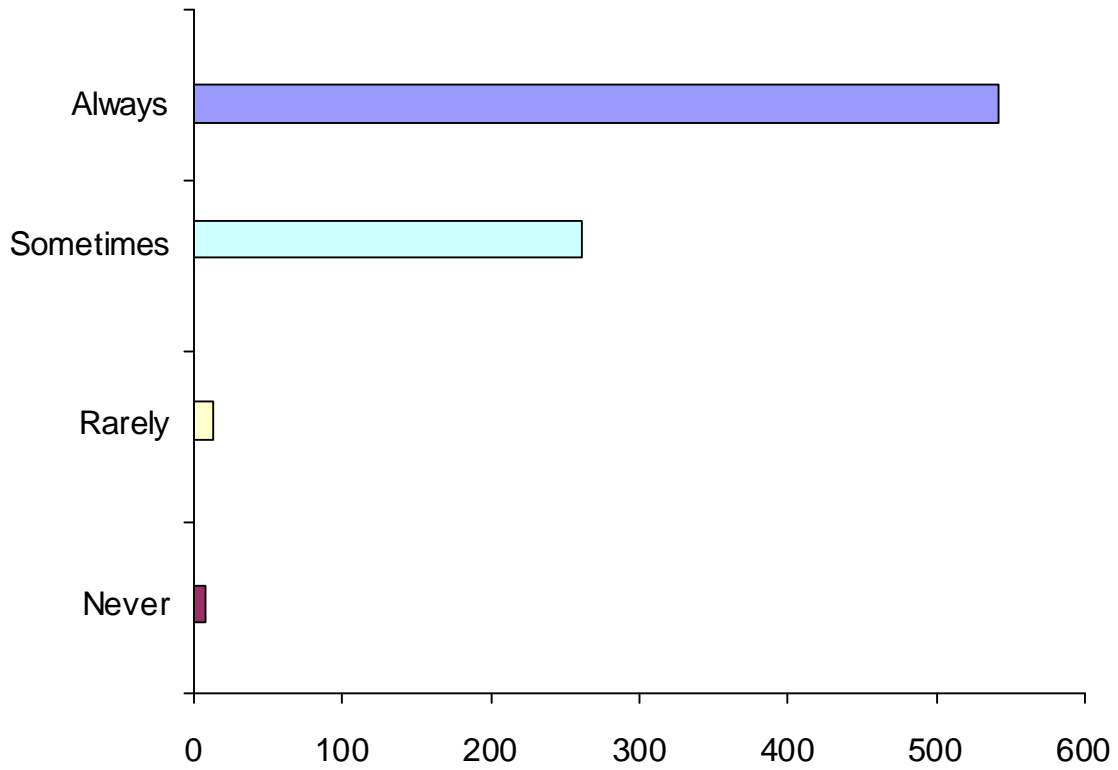
Q54: Would you like to see alternative faith groups established in Swavesey?

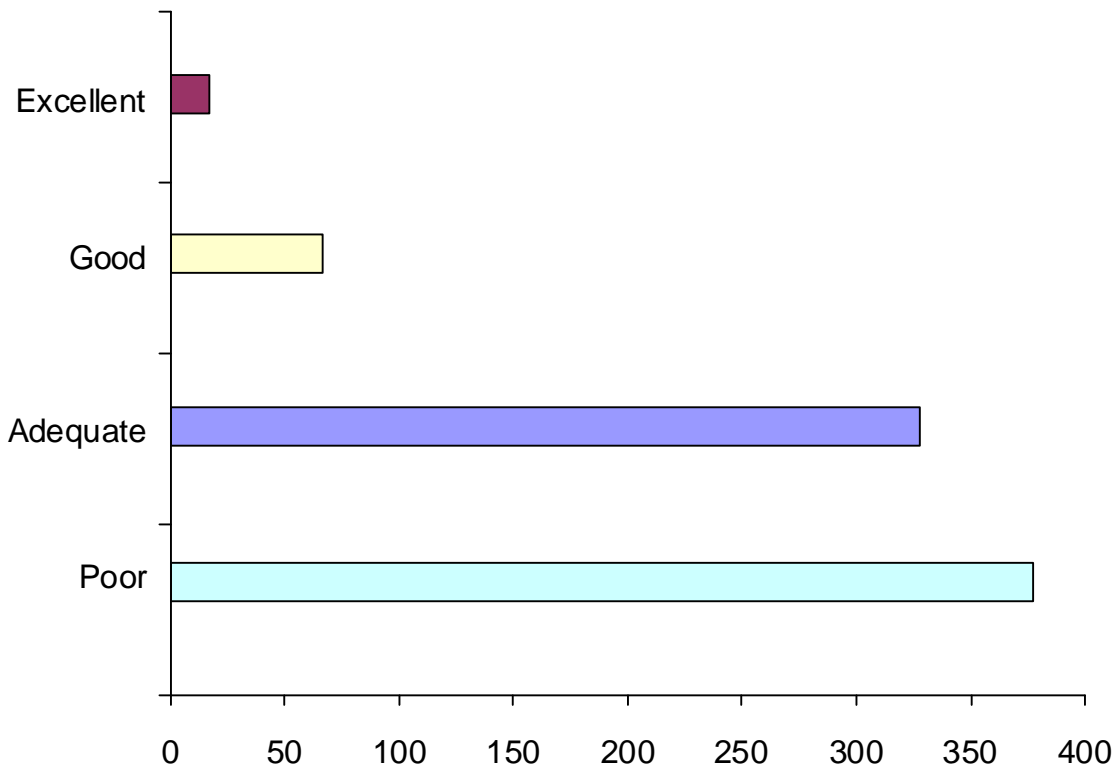
Q56: Do you feel safe in the village?

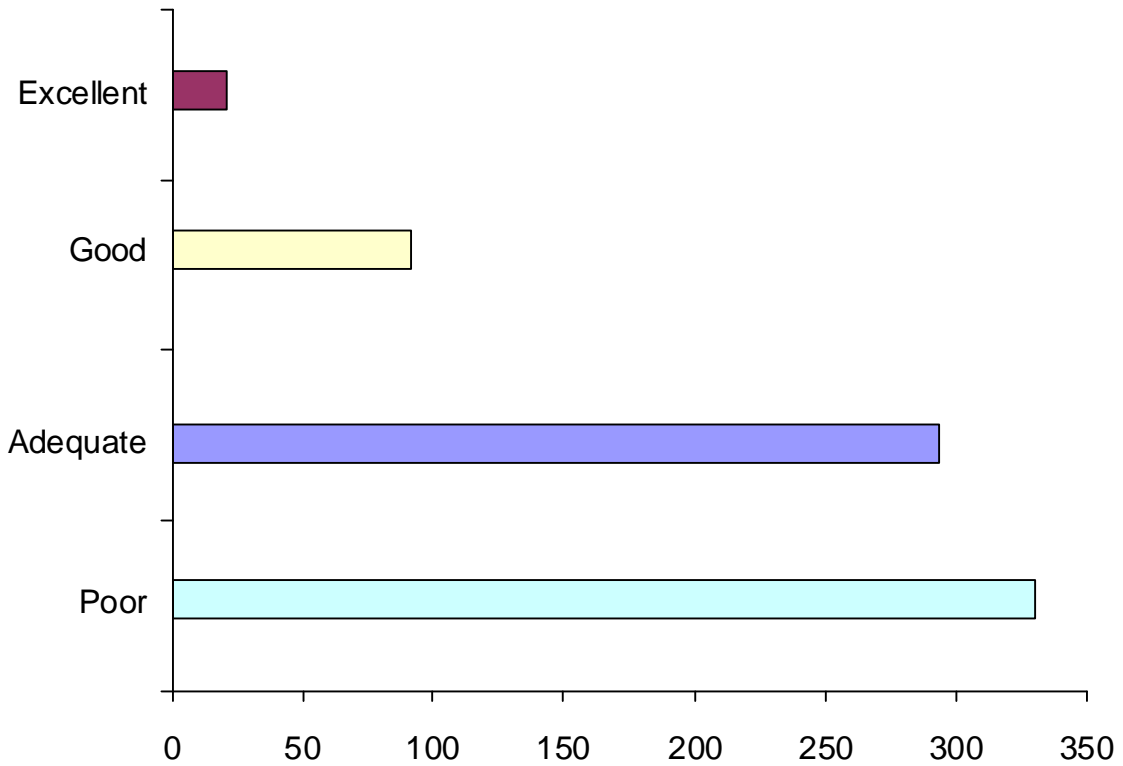
Q57: Do you think that the Police presence in Swavesey is ...?

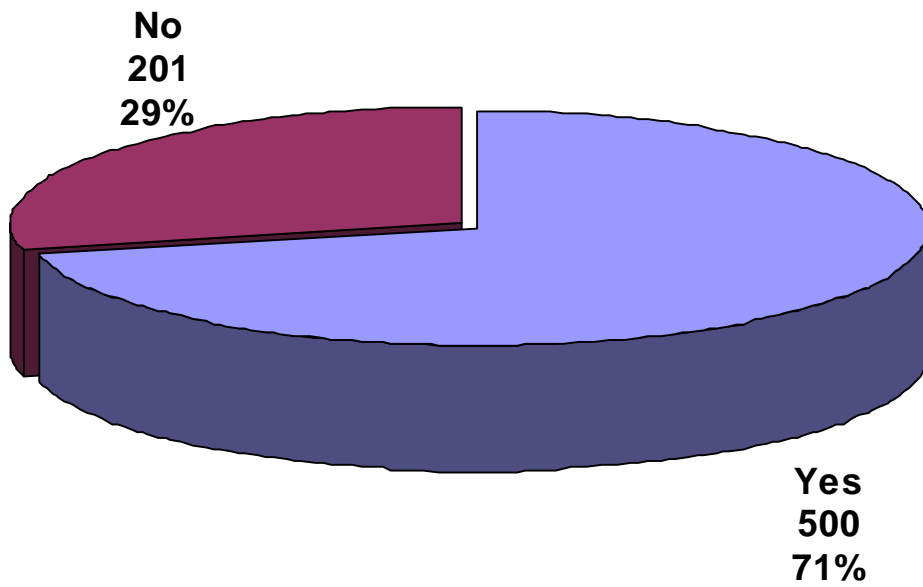
Q58: Do you think that the Police Community Support Officer presence in Swavesey is...?
