This year we decided to bring the Memorial Hall a step closer to the future; Wi-Fi has now been connected for all hall users.

Bookings for the hall have been increasing especially resident's bookings, which is pleasing to see now that you have a fully functional hall on your doorstep. It is very much the thought of the Trustees, for the Hall to stand on its own without the need for the running grant from the Parish Council.

The main developments for the Hall this year have been repointing the bricks on the front pillars and around the emergency exit doors. Feedback from various residents and users of the Hall show they have been delighted with the new doors.

It is hoped that over the next few months we will replace the Hall floor as it's certainly showing wear and tear and the memories of the years it's been walked on! Another project we are also looking to achieve in the future is a new front door to compliment the new internal doors; however this will be subject to grant funding, so watch this space.

Hopefully residents and user groups have appreciated the ongoing changes that have been made in the past year and can look forward to more in the future.
