CAMBRIDGESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(RAMPER ROAD, SWAVESEY)
(40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 20\$\$

The Cambridgeshire County Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and 84(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of this proposal will be to implement a 40mph speed limit on Ramper Road, Swavesey from a point 191 metres east of its junction with Boxworth Road for 330 metres in a generally south-easterly direction.

The draft Order, together with a map showing the road and length of road concerned and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at Reception, Shire Hall, Castle Hill, Cambridge, CB3 0AP or at South Cambridgeshire District Council, South Cambridgeshire Hall, Cambourne Business Park, Cambourne, Cambs CB23 6EA during normal office hours
