



A14 Cambridge to Huntingdon improvement scheme - Huntingdon

About the scheme

Work to improve the A14 between Cambridge and Huntingdon began in November 2016 and is progressing well. The scheme will:

- combat congestion
- unlock economic growth
- improve safety
- connect communities
- leave a positive legacy

The project includes a major new A14 bypass to the south of Huntingdon, widening of parts of the existing A1 and A14, and the removal of the A14 viaduct in Huntingdon. The new bypass is expected to open to traffic by the end of 2020.

About the work in Huntingdon

Once the new A14 bypass is built, the existing A14 through Huntingdon will become a local road and handed over to Cambridgeshire County Council.

While the main work is anticipated to begin in 2019, preparation work, such as archaeology and utility diversions, will start ahead of that. The Huntingdon work will include:

- A new Mill Common link road
- Removal of the A14 viaduct and work around the station
- A new Views Common link road
